Diaper Bank for Northeast Florida ensures families in our community have access to the diapers they need to keep their babies clean, dry and healthy.

A Message From Our Founder & Executive Director

Dear Friends & Supporters,

Every diaper distributed represents one less worry for a parent and one more baby who can stay clean, dry, and healthy. In 2025, thanks to your generosity, Diaper Bank for Northeast Florida provided more than 430,000 diapers to 8,616 babies across our community, offering relief and stability to families facing diaper insecurity.

Diaper insecurity is a pressing yet often overlooked issue. According to The National Diaper Bank Network's 2024 Diaper Check, nearly one in two U.S. families (47%) cannot afford an adequate supply of diapers to keep their children clean, dry, and healthy. In Duval County, more than 33,700 children ages three and under live in households struggling to afford diapers. Because diapers are not covered by federal assistance programs, families are often forced to choose between purchasing diapers and paying for basic needs like food, rent and utilities.

As one local mother shared through our partner agency, the Early Learning Coalition of Duval:

"I was stretching my budget and didn't have the money to purchase diapers this week. Receiving diapers meant I could buy groceries without worrying about how I would keep my baby clean."

For these parents and caregivers, your support of our mission meant fewer impossible choice such as buying diapers or paying for food, rent or utilities.

Thanks to the extraordinary generosity of our supporters and the increased engagement of our volunteers, 2025 marked a record year of community support for our Diaper Bank. This growth allowed us to respond to the rising demand, expand partnerships, strengthen operations and reach families who might not yet be connected to social services. While the need continues to grow, your support ensures we are ready to meet the demand in the year ahead.

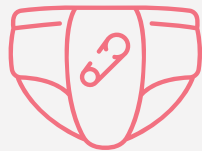

\$100 average cost of diapers per month, but families report only being able to pay a median of \$65.

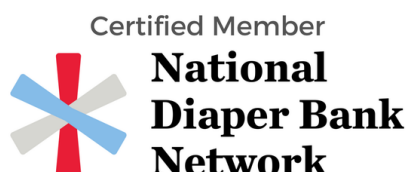

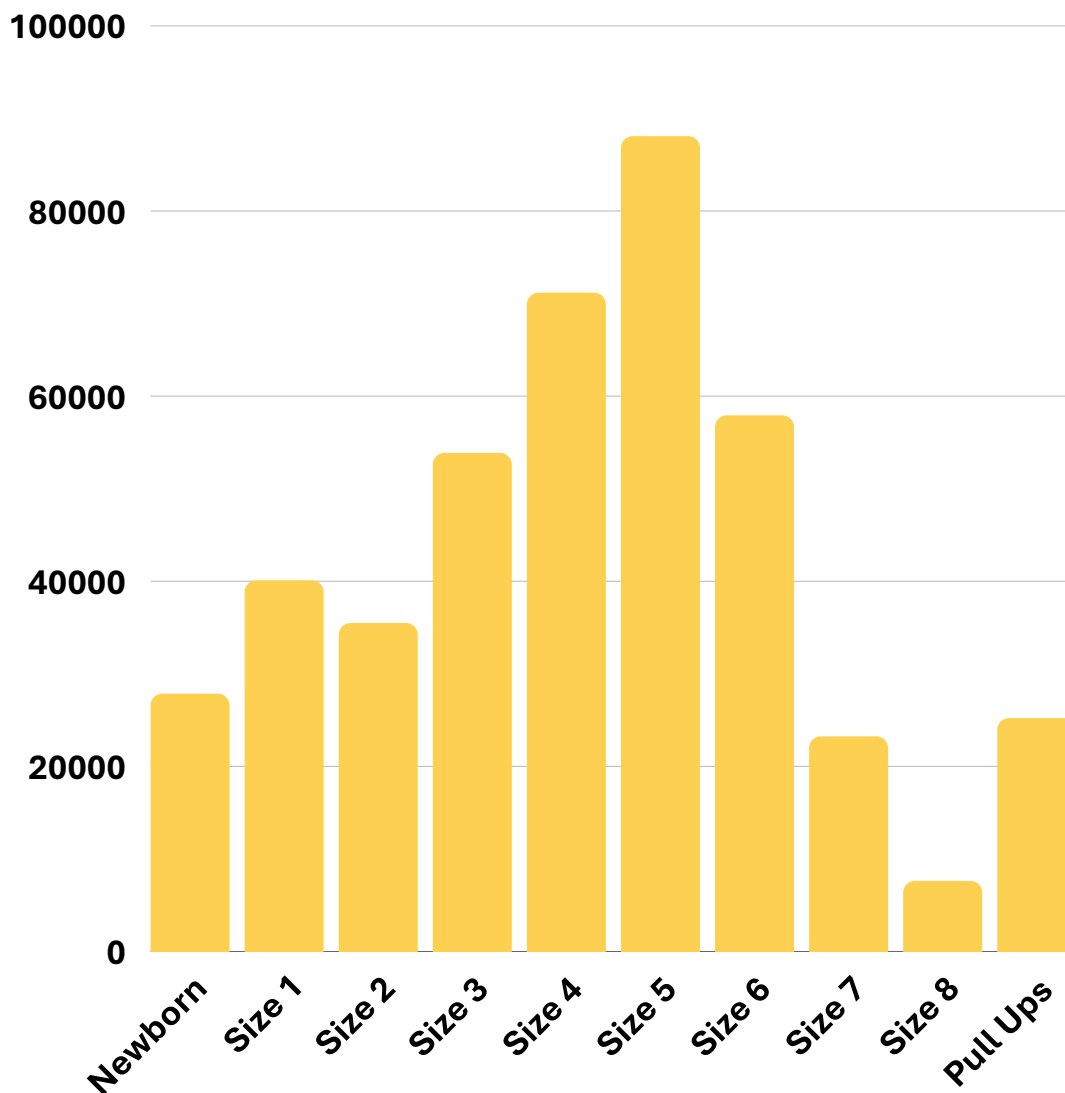
