MISSION OF JESUS AND THE CHURCH

This is the second installment in a series on helping Catholics know how to have constructive conversations with non-Catholics on the issues that are most likely to arise. This article will deal with the goals of Jesus in becoming human and why He formed the Church.

Jesus was incarnated for two main reasons: salvation and sanctification, to save us from our sins and to share His holiness with us. As St. Peter wrote, "God has bestowed on us precious and very great promises, so that through them we may come to share in the divine nature."

Jesus taught and did great things, such as healing, forgiving sins, forming the apostles and changing bread and wine into His body and blood. For the benefit of future Christians, what Jesus said and did was not simply a matter of past history, but here and now can be experienced through the teachings and sacraments of the Catholic Church. He had told His followers He would not leave them orphans.

Our protestant brothers and sisters have much, but not all, that Jesus established for future generations. Only the Catholic Church has the fullness of what Jesus gave us. As stated in Ephesians 1, "God put all things beneath Jesus' feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, which is his body, the fullness of the one who fills all things in every way."
