SALVATION

This is the fourth installment in a series on helping Catholics know how to have constructive conversations with non-Catholics on the issues that are most likely to arise. This article will deal with differences in the understanding of salvation.

Martin Luther, who started the Protestant Reformation in the 16th Century, was initially a Catholic priest. He formed the opinion that Christians are saved by faith alone, that works are not necessary for salvation. This belief, based on Romans 3:28, is complemented by a passage in Romans 10 that "If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." So many Protestants believe that a Christian is saved by making a heartfelt profession of faith in Jesus.

Catholics are careful not to read passages in the Bible in isolation of other passages that address the same issue. In Romans 2, St. Paul wrote that "God will repay everyone according to his works," and "those who observe the law will be justified." He wrote in the Letter to the Philippians, "Work out your salvation with fear and trembling." Martin Luther wanted the Letter of James removed from the Bible. Why? Because James wrote that "Faith, of itself, if it does not have works, is dead."

Catholics believe that, ultimately, we are saved by the grace won by Jesus through His suffering and death. But that grace can be resisted by our free will, and our faith must be evidenced in how we live.

"Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father." Matthew 5:16
