A CLOSING MESSAGE

I started writing these short pieces for the bulletin late in 2019. The basic idea was to communicate messages that would be particularly helpful to families and would be of interest to others in our parish community. I hope and pray that these articles were beneficial, as this is my last submission.

As a closing message, I want to express an aspect of our faith that is not often expressed. In the Catholic Church, we focus a great deal on doctrine. We often hear the criticism that too many Catholics don't know their faith. So we are encouraged to read the Catechism. Learning our faith means learning what we as Catholics believe and what we do.

There's more to faith than doctrine. Doctrine is the roadmap, but not the destination. As emphasized by two great saints, St. Bonaventure and St. Bernard of Clairvaux, conversion of heart is a function of the work of the divine voice experienced in a mystical way by each of us.

In the words of St. Bonaventure, "We must suspend the operations of the mind and transform the peak of our affections, directing them to God alone. This is a sacred mystical experience. It cannot be comprehended unless one surrenders to it; nor can one surrender to it unless he longs for it, nor can he long for it unless inflamed by the Holy Spirit." We must hear in a spiritual way the inner voice of God, revealing His personal love.
