FROM THE DESK OF HEAD COACH ADAM CLACK

Dear Parkview Alumni and Supporters,

My name is Adam Clack, and I am humbled and honored to introduce myself as the new Head Football Coach at Parkview High School. This marks my 18th year in education and coaching, a journey that has taken me through programs like South Forsyth, West Forsyth, and Milton High School, with stops at the University of Charlotte and even overseas in the European League of Football. Along the way, I've founded two player development platforms—Flag Factory and the Adam Clack Football Academy—focused on holistic athlete development and leadership training. But in many ways, this opportunity at Parkview feels like a homecoming. As a 1999 graduate of Winder-Barrow High School and a proud three-sport athlete, I had a front-row seat to the meteoric rise of Parkview athletics. Competing against Parkview in those days was like facing a machine—relentless, tough, and full of pride. That impression stuck with me. Over the years, I've come to know many Parkview alumni and coaches, and the reverence they carry for this community has always been unmistakable.

In fact, my very first head coaching interview was right here at Parkview back in 2014. I didn't get the job then—but it sharpened me for the opportunity that followed at West Forsyth. And as fate would have it, nearly a decade later, a phone call brought me back to this doorstep. I wasn't even looking to return to the sidelines at the time, but some opportunities are simply too powerful to ignore. Stepping into this role hasn't been without challenge. A 3-7 season left the locker room fractured. Key players had transferred, the pipeline from our GFL youth program was unstable, and community support—once Parkview's backbone—was waning. But what ultimately convinced me to return wasn't just the chance to coach again. It was *you*. The Parkview alumni base is unmatched—your history, your pride, and your voice echo through these hallways and down these sidelines. That's why one of my very first actions as head coach was to launch the Celebration of Excellence Dinner, a night to honor our legacy and lay the foundation for our

future. If you were able to attend, I hope you felt the deep respect I have for your contributions to this program.

Now we turn the page, and I need your help to write the next chapter. In an age of constant digital noise, I wanted to create a reliable, direct line of communication—*this newsletter*. Over the next six months, we'll use it to connect, inform, and ignite the Parkview Football community.

This is a grassroots campaign, and we're building it brick by brick—from the ground up. That's why I'm asking you to not only subscribe, but to *share this newsletter* with anyone you know who has ever worn the Paw or cheered from the stands. Whether they played here, coached here, taught here, or simply love this place—we want them in the huddle with us. Every supporter matters.
