CALL FOR ARTIST

We are seeking a local artist to create 28 Awards for the 2026 National Philanthropy Day

What is National Philanthropy Day?

The Association of Fundraising Professionals Central Florida Chapter (AFP) recognizes and honors donors, volunteers, professionals, and organizations whose gifts of time, expertise and resources contribute significantly to the quality of life in our community at this event.

When is National Philanthropy Day?

Friday, November 13, 2026 at 8:30 a.m.

Why choose a local artist?

AFP chooses to highlight a local artist annually to create the unique awards presented to the winners and sponsors to bring awareness to the artist, and provide a “one of a kind” award.

What is the budget for each award?

Up to \$130 per award

Does the artist receive any other perks?

Yes, they will be given two seats to attend the event, recognition during the event program, and a ¼ page ad in Orange Appeal Magazine’s Nov/Dec issue.

How many awards will be needed?

28 awards total, including 5 distinguished awards, 18 honoree* awards, 1 for Presenting Sponsor, 2 for event Co-Chairs, 1 for AFP Chapter President, and 1 for volunteer MC

**The honoree awards can be slightly smaller if desired*

Are there size or material requirements?

No, we are looking for creative awards that intertwine the theme of the event.

What does the award need to incorporate/include?

- The “heart” shape from the National Philanthropy Day logo (see above)
- A frame or stand (if necessary)
- A place holder for the 1-7/8 x 4 inch name plate that will be affixed to each award
- Two size options for various award levels

Who compiles the information and orders the name plates for the awards?

The National Philanthropy Day Committee will handle these details.

Can an artist submit more than one idea?

Yes!

What should I submit with my proposal?

- A sketch of your idea(s)
- 2-4 photos of representative works
- A description of the award
- A brief letter of interest
- Pricing per award

What is needed from the selected artist?

A signed Artist Agreement and a W-9 Form

Important Dates to Remember

Submission Deadline: June 15, 2026

Artist Selection & Notification: By July 31, 2026

Award Completion/Delivery: November 1, 2026
