Deodorant

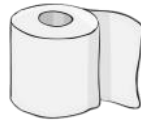
Shampoo

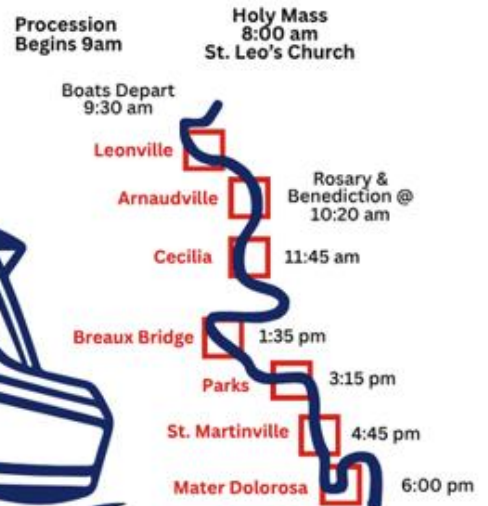
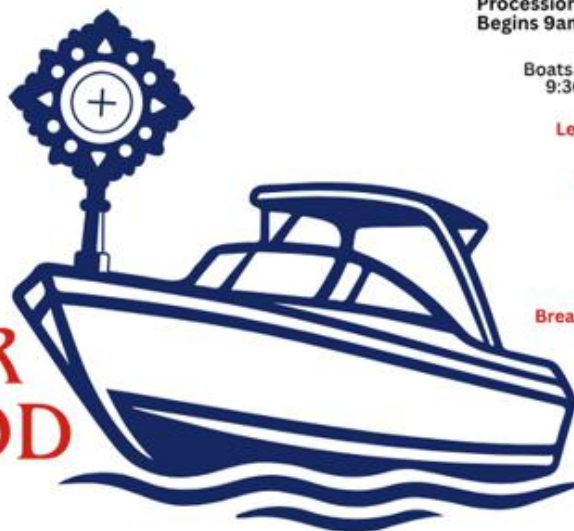
