DIRECTIONS TO STEWARD ST. ELIZABETH'S MEDICAL CENTER

If you will be receiving sedation during your procedure, you must be accompanied by a responsible adult, whether driving to the hospital, or using public transportation.

From the West: Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) East to Exit 17 (Newton-Watertown). Go straight and take the second right onto Park Street, following signs for Brighton. Take the first left onto Tremont Street and follow for approximately one mile until it connects to the right with Washington Street. Continue on Washington Street for approximately one mile to the Medical Center.

From the North: Take I-93 South to the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) West. Follow the Mass Pike to Exit 20 (Brighton-Cambridge). Proceed through the tollbooth and bear left towards Allston/Brighton (Cambridge Street). Follow H signs for approximately 1.5 miles to the Medical Center.

From the South: Take I-93 North to the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) West. Follow the Mass Pike to Exit 20 (Brighton-Cambridge). Proceed through the tollbooth and bear left towards Allston/Brighton (Cambridge Street). Follow H signs for approximately 1.5 miles to the Medical Center.

From Downtown Boston: Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) West. Follow the Mass Pike to Exit 20 (Brighton-Cambridge). Proceed through the tollbooth and bear left towards Allston/Brighton (Cambridge Street). Follow H signs for approximately 1.5 miles to the Medical Center.

Parking Information: On-site parking is available at the Medical Center. You may self park in Garage B for a nominal charge. **Valet** parking also is available at the Main Entrances for a fee.

Via Public Transportation: Green Line: Take a B, C, or D Green Line train to Kenmore Station. Go upstairs to the bus pavilion and take the #57 bus (Watertown Square) to St. Elizabeth's. The bus stops directly across from the Medical Center.

Boston College B Train on the Green Line: Take the B train to Warren Street and Commonwealth Avenue. Walk north to the end of Warren Street. Take a left onto Nevins Street, to the Main Entrance of St. Elizabeth's, or take a left onto Cambridge Street and enter the Medical Center through the street level entrance.

Red Line: You have two (2) options when taking the Red Line to St. Elizabeth's:

1. Take the Red Line to Central Square. Go to the bus stop at the corner of Western Avenue and Green Street, and take the #64 (Oak Square) bus.
2. Take the Red Line to Harvard Square. Go to the bus stop at the corner of Massachusetts Avenue and Garden Street, and take the #86 (Cleveland Circle) bus.

Both buses stop at the corner of Washington and Market Streets in Brighton Center. Get off at this stop and walk two (2) blocks east on Washington Street to St. Elizabeth's.

Express Bus: Take the Express Bus from the Financial District to St. Elizabeth's, Monday through Friday. To confirm the bus schedules, please contact the MBTA at (617)722-3200, or at www.mbta.com.

When you arrive at the hospital:

Enter via the main entrance. If you **have pre-registered**, go directly to the GI unit located on the 5th floor of the Seton Pavilion. If you **have not pre registered**, report to the admitting office located just off the main lobby on the 4th floor of the Seton Pavilion.
