## Pupil premium strategy outcomes

Desired Outcomes	Outcome
Pupils make at least expected progress in reading, writing and maths.	Better outcomes in Year 1 than previous year (comparing Spring data). New Year 1 model has been embedded, children are happier and progress this year has improved.  Spring assessment data shows there needs to be a stronger focus on Year 5 and 6 – particularly in writing.
Pupils access high quality first teaching within the classroom to meet their needs.	Learning walks show that most pupils accessing quality first teaching however, there are gaps in SEND provision.  Training from EP and Wandsworth Literacy Advisor during Summer term to support this.
Pupils access a wide range of interventions to meet their needs.	Lego therapy FreshStart Phonics AHT Yr 4, 5 writing Group School therapist and Unlocking Potential therapist Phonics Interventions for Yr 1 and 2 Nurture groups (Y2 and Y5)
PP attendance increases.	Slight increase in attendance for PPG pupils 29.5.25 was 89.6%. (Attendance for PPG pupils by July 2024 was 88.3%)
Pupils access a wide range of enrichment experiences both in and out of school.	After School Clubs (Every PPG child entitled to one free school-run club) Wrap Around Care Music Service (learning to play recorder + brass instrument, singing festivals and concerts) Trips (e.g. Y5 and 6 residential, Aquarium, Play in a day, Wetlands, concerts, City Zoo, Theatre, Pantomime, trips to local library) Journey Through the Stars
Pupils have correct school uniform	All PPG pupils given a school jumper and t-shirt.
