2. Education Home and School report- Lynn Sauer

*Teachers are reviewing math and science standards. The Archdiocese is planning to replace current standards with the Wisconsin State standards.

*Kari Stone was hired as a part-time cleaner. Her position begins in May, 2026.

*DSCS has received a \$110,000 grant from the Bruce Krier foundation to complete safety initiatives. Security doors, new windows and rekeying the building are all projects funded through the grant.

3. Parish Director's Report: Deb Hamm

*The Archdiocese is in the process of reorganizing. New sites are being explored.

*Six new priests have been ordained. The following classes are smaller and the number of retiring priests is outnumbering newly ordained clergy.

*Parish Directors will no longer be assigned to a term, but rather contracts will be offered on a yearly basis.

*The Easter Egg hunts at the parishes were popular.

*First Communion and Confirmation were celebrated in our parishes.

*Fr. Andrew Infanger will be the priest for the Procession of Corpus Christi in Dacada (St Nicholas chapel) on June 7, 2026 at 1:00 PM.

*Fr. Ariel Orozco was recently named as a pastor in Mukwonago and will not be returning to DSCS in the Fall.

*Fr. Don Thimm will be celebrating his 50th Anniversary of his Ordination. There will be a celebration on May 31, 2026 following the 10:00 AM Mass at Divine Savior with a pot-luck lunch hosted by the Pastoral Councils.

*Both parishes will have safety cameras installed.

3. Old Business:

*Joint meeting minutes from March were approved. Rusty Zimmerman motioned to approve, seconded by Marilyn Sabec.

*Walk to Mary- Bryan Bichler and his daughter, Sarah, participated in the Walk to Mary from St. Norbert's to the Shrine in Champion. The 22 mile walk was attended by over 10,000 participants.
