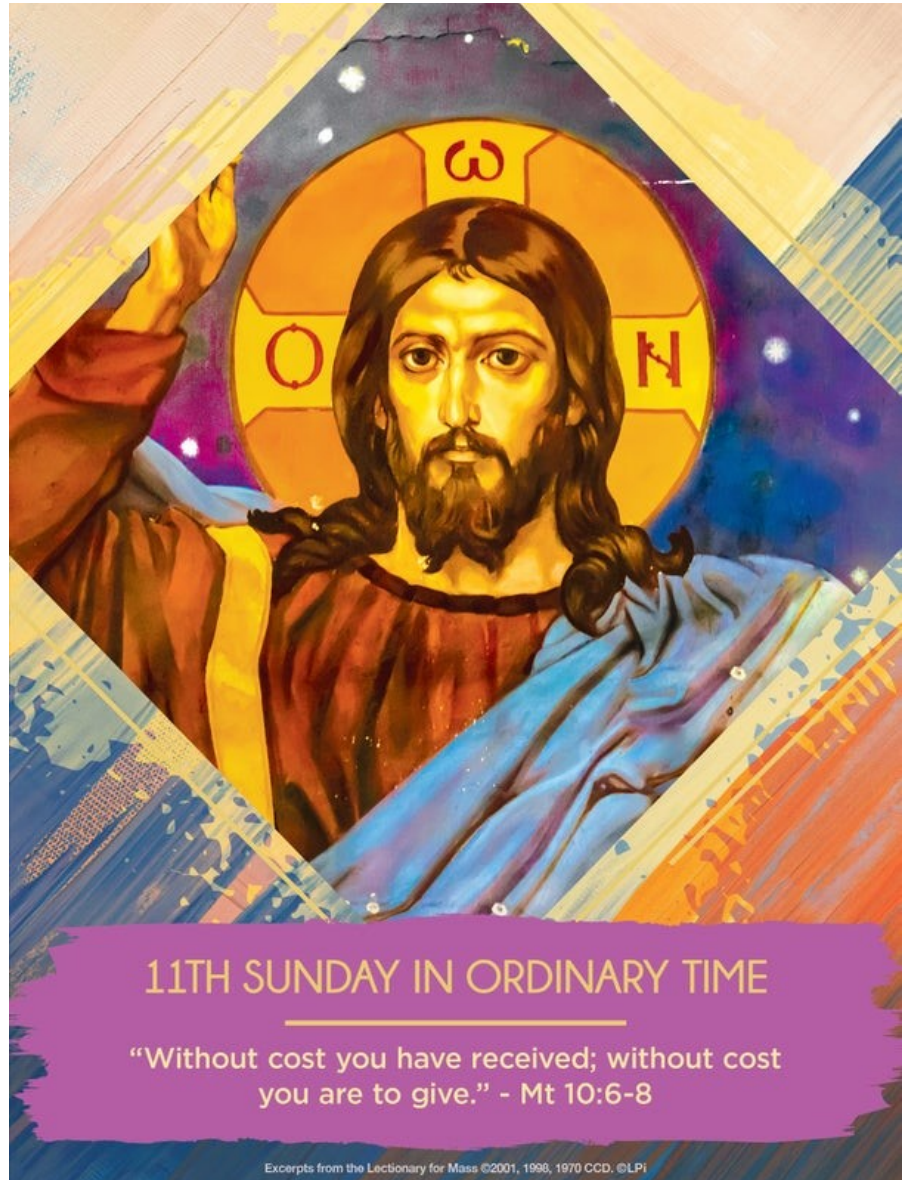

The book of Exodus tells of the Israelites' escape from Egypt and their journey to Mount Sinai some 1200 years before Christ. In today's passage, the stage is set for the Old Testament's most dramatic encounter between God and the chosen people.

Today and for many Sundays hereafter, our second reading will be taken from Paul's letter to the Romans. The theme of today's section from Paul's letter to the Romans is the great theological question of how sinners can be united with God who is all holy. Paul presents the Christian answer to this question.

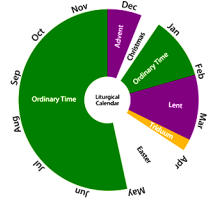

Today is the 11<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time...Just what is *Ordinary Time*?




**The color green in the church tells us that we are back in Ordinary Time.** Actually the word “ordinary” does not mean routine but “counted” or “ordinal” time. Winter Ordinary Time is just a few short weeks until we enter into the season of Lent. Summer and Fall Ordinary Time comprise the longest portion of the Liturgical Year, covering as much as six months of the Calendar. Ordinary Time challenges us with the demands of building the Kingdom. We listen to the Word of God which keeps reminding us of our call as Christians to internalize the teachings of the Lord and to live out what we proclaim. The miracles and the parables of Jesus are, for the most part, the subject of the Gospel readings. The task that we are given is the same task Jesus had - to proclaim the reign of God in our midst - so this is hardly an ordinary mission. The prayers of the Mass ask for the gifts necessary to accomplish this task and they carry the same message: “Bring forth the Kingdom!” *Copyright © 2010 Resource Publications, Inc. 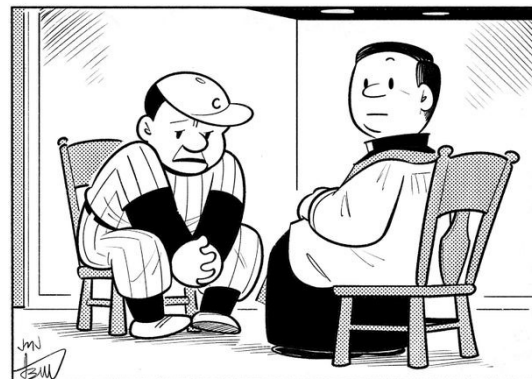
