Children's Empowerment Group

A **FREE** ten-week **VIRTUAL** psychoeducational group for children 6-12 years old who have witnessed domestic violence, community violence, or have been a victim of abuse.

Each session involves fun arts and crafts that fit the topic of day (Materials will be given to all participants).

The goal of this group is early intervention and education for children being physically abused or witnessing violence in their homes and communities. The curriculum focuses on building active skills needed by children to identify problem situations and make appropriate choices, as well as build coping skills, self-esteem, support, and safety planning.

Group participants will need to commit to attending all weeks with parental help in logging into **zoom**.
