However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services of the Funeral Director, Staff, & Overhead

\$1,900

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

- Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial call
- Arrangement conference with next of kin or responsible legally recognized party
- Data collection and preparation of necessary authorizations and permits
- Recording of vital statistics, reporting to social security, administrative document filing, preparation and placement of obituary notices
- Coordinating funeral and disposition details
- Overhead, including professional licensing, facility maintenance, equipment and inventory costs, insurance and administrative expenses, and governmental compliance with state and federal codes.

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial that does not require you to pay for it.

Minimum Services

Minimum Services are a "Direct Cremation" or "Immediate Burial". These are reduced cost services without a ceremony or viewing. The price ranges are the minimum services plus the cost of requested merchandise.

Direct Cremation Package

\$2,150+

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are cardboard.

A direct cremation is a cremation service without the decedent present for a viewing, visitation, or ceremony. This charge includes basic services and overheads, removal of the deceased from place of death, standard sheltering of the remains in a temperature controlled environment (initial 3 days), cremation procedure and permits (<300lbs) and temporary urn (cardboard or plastic).

It does not include merchandise, placement location, and cash advances such as death certificates.

Forwarding of Remains

\$2,950

This charge includes a basic services and overhead fee, removal of the decedent from place of death, dressing/casketing, embalming (if relevant), and securing necessary authorization and permits. It does not include a casket or other container for the deceased, transportation to the airport (SeaTac or PDX), additional transportation fees, or other fees related to U.S. travel or international travel (airlines, consulate, etc.), death certificates, or the use of facilities for visitation or ceremonies prior to departure of the deceased.

Receiving of Remains

\$2,750

This charge includes basic professional service and overhead fee, pickup at SeaTac or PDX, temporary shelter of the remains, service vehicle and transportation to final destination.

It does not include a casket or other container for the deceased, additional transportation fees, or other fees related to U.S. travel or international travel (airlines, consulate, etc.), or the use of facilities for visitation or ceremonies prior to departure of the deceased.

Immediate Burial

Our charge for an immediate burial (without ceremony) includes: basic services of a funeral director and overheads, dressing/casketing, 3 days' refrigeration, removal of remains and local transportation to cemetery.

Burial With Service \$3,850+

A burial with a service includes a service held at a location and/or a graveside service. This is a burial arranged on the schedule of the family, staff and cemetery with guests present. This charge includes a basic services and overhead fee (\$1,900), removal of the deceased from place of death (\$450), standard sheltering of the remains in a temperature controlled environment (initial 3 days) (\$300), dressing/shrouding/casketing (\$300), use of equipment and staff for graveside service (\$500), transportation to the cemetery (initial 25 mile radius included) (\$400 hearse/\$300 service vehicle), and/or use of facilities and staff for funeral service (\$500). There are additional expenses for weekend services (\$500), embalming (\$700), viewing (\$300), and non-local/after-hours transportation.

It does not include cemetery property or expenses such as cost of plot, opening/closing, casket/shroud/outer burial container, and cash advance selections such as death certificates.
