From the Desk of the Pastor

STEWARDSHIP

Our topic this month touches every facet of our lives as followers of Christ: stewardship. Often, when we hear the word "stewardship," our minds immediately go to finances, and while that is certainly a vital aspect, stewardship encompasses far more. It is about faithfully managing everything God has entrusted

to us - our resources, our talents, and indeed, our very lives. Let us first consider the gift of our time. This is perhaps the most precious and easily squandered gift we possess. Unlike money, which can be earned and lost and sometimes regained, time is irrevocably lost once it has passed. Every minute is a fleeting moment that will never return. We are constantly reminded in Scripture of the brevity of our days; as Psalm 90:12 says, "So teach us to number our days, that we may get a heart of wisdom." We live in a world that constantly vies for our attention, tempting us to fill our moments with distractions and trivialities. Yet, our time here on earth is incredibly short in the grand scheme of eternity. Secondly, let us reflect on the gift of our money. This is not merely an obligation, but a profound act of worship. Every penny we possess, every resource we acquire, is a gift from His generous hand. It is a testament to God's faithful provision in our lives. When we give cheerfully and sacrificially, we are not diminishing our own lives, but rather affirming our trust in His ability to provide for all our needs. Our giving shows that we truly value God above worldly possessions, demonstrating that our hearts are fixed on heavenly treasures rather than earthly ones. As 2 Corinthians 9:7 reminds us, "Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, god God loves a cheerful giver." Let us embrace generosity not only as a duty, but as a joyful response to the immeasurable grace we have received.

Let's prayerfully consider how we are stewarding both our time and our money. May we be found faithful in managing these precious gifts, using them for God's glory, for the advancement of His kingdom,

and for the blessing of those around us.



Light from the Word "FINDING THE RIGHT ROUTE"






