Call to Application  Think through claims: Refuse to be captivated by miraculous displays lacking a biblical base.  Center your entire spiritual compass on the reliable authority of the Scriptures alone.
	1 John 4:1: "Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God; for many false prophets have gone out into the world."	Critical Discernment: Treat every new spiritual teaching or "revelation" as subject to Scripture. Do not accept anything unless it stands up to the scrutiny of the established Gospel of Jesus Christ and His teachings.
	2 Peter 3:10: "But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a loud noise, and the elements will be dissolved with fire, and the earth and everything that is done on it will be exposed."	Live with Urgency: Since the time is unknown, your mandate is to maximize your faithfulness in the present moment, living as if today is your last day.

MAKE UP YOUR MIND: Be Pre-Decided for Testimony	1 Peter 3:15: "Always be prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and reverence."
