Surviving To Thriving Conference NorCal Request For Assistance (RFA) Information

NorCal C.O.P.S. will reimburse survivors for airfare (up to \$500-basic fare) for those that choose to attend the Surviving To Thriving Conference and did not attend their respective Survivor Weekend. To request travel assistance, complete the attached form and **return by October 16, 2026.**

- ★ This RFA form must be submitted to NorCal C.O.P.S. Treasurer, Tony Aguerre by email at: tony.aguerre@norcalcops.org by the deadline (October 16, 2026) for consideration.
- ★ The executive board members will vote on the RFA's after they are received and before the conference starts.
- ★ If you have been approved/denied, you will receive notice through email.
- ★ Upon return from the event, receipts for airfare must be sent to the treasurer within 30 days of the conclusion of the conference.
- ★ In order to receive funds from NorCal C.O.P.S. you must attend the conference events in their entirety.
- ★ Flights are reimbursed up to \$500 (at Basic Fare) per person for the Surviving To Thriving Conference.

Hotel Reimbursement will be available by National C.O.P.S. as noted below:

*If a survivor chooses to attend this conference in place of their survivor specific weekend or camp, their registration fee will be waived and they will be eligible to have the cost of their hotel room for up to 3 nights stay reimbursed by National C.O.P.S. In order to be eligible, survivors must submit their hotel receipt to National C.O.P.S. within 30 days of the conference and attend all planned sessions and activities. National C.O.P.S. will not reimburse the cost for any meals, however, the conference will provide 2 lunches and one dinner during the conference.
