

1. Enter Provisioning Mode:

- Find the “boot” button on your device. See images below.
- Using a paperclip or similar sized tool, press and hold the button for at least 20 seconds, then release.
- A blinking LED will indicate the device is in provisioning mode.

2. Set Up Using the Blynk App:

- Open the Blynk app on your smartphone.
- Make sure your phone is connected to the new Wi-Fi network you want the device to use.
- Tap on the device you want to update.
- Tap the three-dot menu in the top-right corner.
- Choose “Reconfigure” from the menu.

3. Follow the In-App Steps:

- The app will prompt you to connect to the device’s temporary Wi-Fi.
- After connecting, enter the new Wi-Fi name (SSID) and password.
- The device will reboot and try to connect to the new network.
