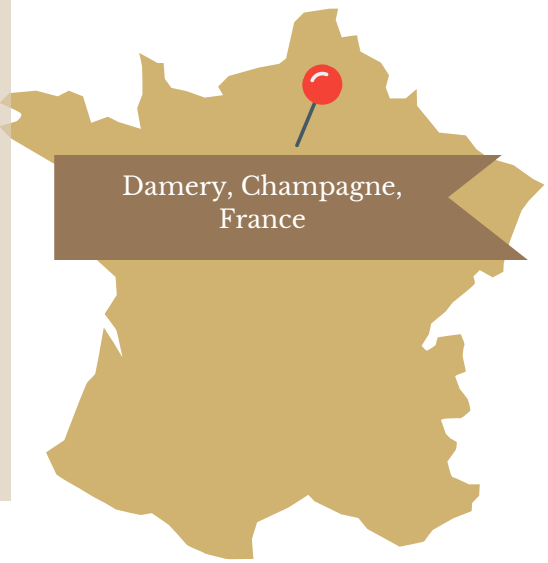

AR Lenoble, “Mag 20,” Brut

Damery, Champagne, France

This cuvée showcases the elegance and complexity that the “Mag” series is known for, with a 2020 base vintage making up 55% of the blend. The inclusion of reserve wines aged in magnum under cork (a technique unique to Lenoble) adds depth and subtle oxidative character. Expect ripe orchard fruits, golden apple, a hint of toast, and vibrant acidity. The low dosage (3 g/L) keeps things focused and dry, letting the terroir shine.

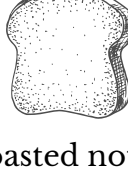
Champagne Assailly "Mongamin", Blanc de Blancs, Grand Cru

Avize, Champagne, France

The "Mongamin" cuvée is a special one—originally created in 1938 by Maurice Assailly for his son, Christian. It's made from 100% Chardonnay grapes sourced exclusively from a single Grand Cru parcel in Avize. Fermented in stainless steel and aged on the lees for an extended period, it offers a refined and complex profile. Expect aromas of mature yeast and toasted notes, leading to a full, complex, and persistent palate with a hint of sweetness.

Verzy, Montagne de Reims, Champagne, France

A 100% Pinot Noir Blanc de Noirs exclusively from the Grand Cru village of Verzy, this bottle leans into power and structure while still keeping things silky and elegant. Coming from a top small Grower-Producer champagne house, this champagne is extremely unique based on its terroir. Only a few hundred years ago, the Village of Verzy was a Flint quarry which has greatly affected the unique characteristics of the Pinot Noir. You'll get a deep core of red fruit and a bit of spicy smokey notes with a textured, full-bodied feel—perfect with richer dishes like grilled red meats or savory salmon.

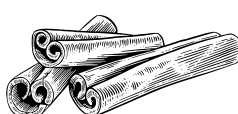
Duval-Leroy is a family-owned Champagne house founded in 1859 in Vertus, known for combining tradition with innovation. Carol Duval-Leroy made history as the first woman to lead a major Champagne house and helped modernize the brand while staying focused on sustainability. Today, her three sons are continuing the legacy, producing high-quality Champagne from some of the best vineyards in the region. This non-vintage Brut is a blend of 90% Pinot Noir and Meunier with 10% Chardonnay, sourced from Sézanne, the Marne Valley, and Aube. Enriched with reserve wines (40%) and aged 30 to 36 months on the lees, it balances richness and freshness. Expect notes of roasted fig, dark chocolate, and cinnamon, with fine bubbles and a subtly vinous texture. Certified HVE Level 3 for environmental excellence.
