Feast Days




The Feast of Corpus Christi, the weekend of June 7, celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist. Sacred Heart will honor this feast with a Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession following the 5:30 pm mass on **Saturday, June 6**. The procession will follow a route through the church/school campus and the local neighborhood, stopping to worship at altars on the way. Our First Communicants will lead the procession, and we invite all parishioners to join in. We pray for a large turnout to this event as we show our reverence to the source and summit of our Catholic faith, the Holy Eucharist. Please wear comfortable shoes for walking. In the event of rain, the procession will be canceled, but we will still have a period of adoration at the end of mass.
