The Feast of Corpus Christi, the weekend of June 7, celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist. Sacred Heart will honor this feast with a Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession following the **5:30 pm mass on Saturday, June 6.** The procession will follow a route through the church/school campus and the local neighborhood, stopping to worship at altars on the way.

Our First Communicants will lead the procession, and we invite all parishioners to join in. We pray for a large turnout to this event as we show our reverence to the source and summit of our Catholic faith, the Holy Eucharist. Please wear comfortable shoes for walking. In the event of rain, the procession will be canceled, but we will still have a period of adoration at the end of mass.

Corpus Christi Procession:
June 6th, 2026, at end of 5:30 pm mass

What to bring:

- A hat or an umbrella to keep the sun off
- Water will be provided at each station of the route

What to expect at the end:

- Reentering the church at the end of the route, we will have a short period of adoration, followed by solemn benediction.

In the event of rain:

- The procession will be canceled, but we will still have a period of adoration at the end of mass.

Let us pray:

- Asking the intercession of Our Lady and St. Margaret Mary that *God may bless us with cool weather and no rain.*
- Asking God that this event may stoke an ever greater love and appreciation of the Eucharist in the hearts of all the faithful
- Asking God that He bless all the needs of our local community.

Novena of Corpus Christi (5/29-6/6):
Angel of Fatima Prayer

My God, I believe, I adore, I hope, and I love You! I ask pardon of You for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love You! Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I adore You profoundly, and I offer You the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifference with which He Himself is offended. And, through the infinite merits of His most Sacred Heart, and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of You the conversion of poor sinners.

The route:

- We will follow the route below. There will be 3 stations where we will have a short time of reading from Scripture, a short message, and then benediction
- We are arranging with MPD to have police escorts for safety along St. Joseph Street and Broadway Street
- We are hoping to have a few side-by-sides for those who are mobility impaired who wish to be a part
