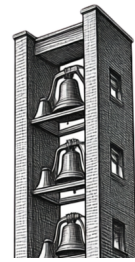

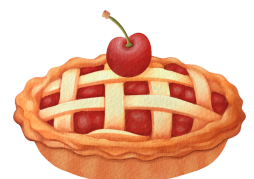


Congrats to our parish's diaconate candidate Mark Hoelzeman, who was installed in the ministry of acolyte on August 9th at Morris Chapel at the diocesan chancery in Little Rock.

In the absence of the deacon, installed acolytes serve at the altar as the principal assistant to the priest, and they are first among Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. They are also the only laypersons who are authorized to purify the Eucharistic vessels at the end of the Communion Rite.

In a couple of months, you will begin seeing Mark serve at the altar on Sundays as an acolyte. This is the final ministry that he receives in anticipation of his diaconate ordination in June 2028. Please continue to keep him and his wife Annie in your prayers.

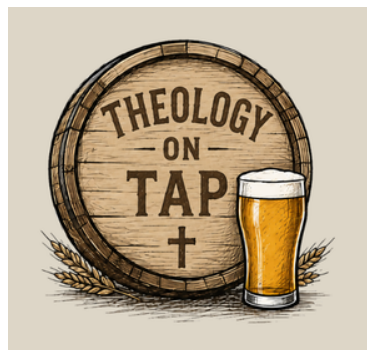

Dear parishioners, we have been having some issues the last 2 months in our **ministry schedules** that I hope a clarification can resolve. Our new ministry software conveniently offers a digital option to **request a sub** when we know we will be unavailable. However, requesting a sub through the software does not mean that we are done. Our policy remains that we are responsible for finding our own subs, so we are still responsible for our individual ministry occasion unless and until we get a notification that the spot has been filled. Please know that you can view the public schedule at any time to see if your name has been replaced with the sub's name (a sub arrow icon appears while the request is out-

standing). I ask that if we are within 1 week and our request has not been fulfilled, we go ahead and use the old-fashioned method of calling or texting in order to secure a sub. A list of minister contacts for each ministry will be texted soon. Thank you so much, Fr. Stephen
