

Diocese of Little Rock Task Force Against Human Trafficking and Pornography



On Tuesday, March 3, following the 5:00 pm Holy Mass, an informative 40-minute presentation will be held addressing the Harms of Social Media, Human Trafficking, and Pornography. This talk will be delivered by a representative from the Diocese of Little Rock Task Force Against Human Trafficking and Pornography. Individuals under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Families and children aged 12 and above are encouraged to attend.



Ash Wednesday's Masses will be at 7:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. (PRE)



While a solemn day, it is not a holy day of obligation.

- For Catholics 14 and over, Ash Wednesday is a day of abstinence, which is defined as refraining from eating the flesh meat of mammals and fowl.
- For Catholics 18-59, Ash Wednesday is also a day of fasting, which is defined as one normal size meal in the course of the day plus two smaller sized meals that, when added together, are still less than the normal meal.
- Those who are ill or pregnant are not obligated to fast, but they are still to observe abstinence.



All Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence for those 14 and over


Did You Know?

Since 2010, our diocese has tracked "October Mass Counts" to understand trends and better respond to the needs of Catholics in Arkansas. October is chosen because it is the month in which people are statistically most likely to be home and not traveling.



The Journey Since 2010: Resilience & Recovery

The graph below shows Sacred Heart's October averages over the last 15 years. While travel during local school breaks in October in recent years have skewed some of these numbers slightly lower than they would otherwise be, you can clearly see the steady vibrance of the 2010s, the significant impact of the 2020 pandemic, and our current upward climb.




The Takeaway: According to an Arkansas Catholic article from February 2025, mass attendance across Arkansas has returned to pre-pandemic levels. Here at Sacred Heart, however, while our 2025 count is the highest it has been in four years, we are still working toward equaling our pre-pandemic attendance.



A Deeper Look: The "Heartbeat" of 2025

To get the most accurate picture of our current attendance, we also calculated the average across the entire year. To find the "true" typical Sunday, we look at the Middle 80%, removing the artificially high peaks (like Easter) & the artificially low valleys (like Fall Break). →



This data shows a consistent community of roughly 589-603 faithful gathering across our four weekend masses.



Our Mission: The Empty Pew

Numbers tell a story, but people are our priority. These statistics highlight a clear opportunity: reaching out to those who have stopped being with us on Sundays. Coming back to the practice of faith can be a hurdle after a long absence. You are the best bridge for them to return.

- **Reflect:** Do you know a Catholic family member or friend who no longer attends?
- **Act:** Consider reaching out and offering to come with them on Sunday.
- **Invite:** It is much easier for someone to return when they have a friend they know and trust waiting for them in the pews.
