The Feast of Corpus Christi, the weekend of June 7, celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist. Sacred Heart will honor this feast with a Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession following the 5:30 pm mass on Saturday, June 6. The procession will follow a route through the church/school campus and the local neighborhood, stopping to worship at altars on the way.

Our First Communicants will lead the procession, and we invite all parishioners to join in.
