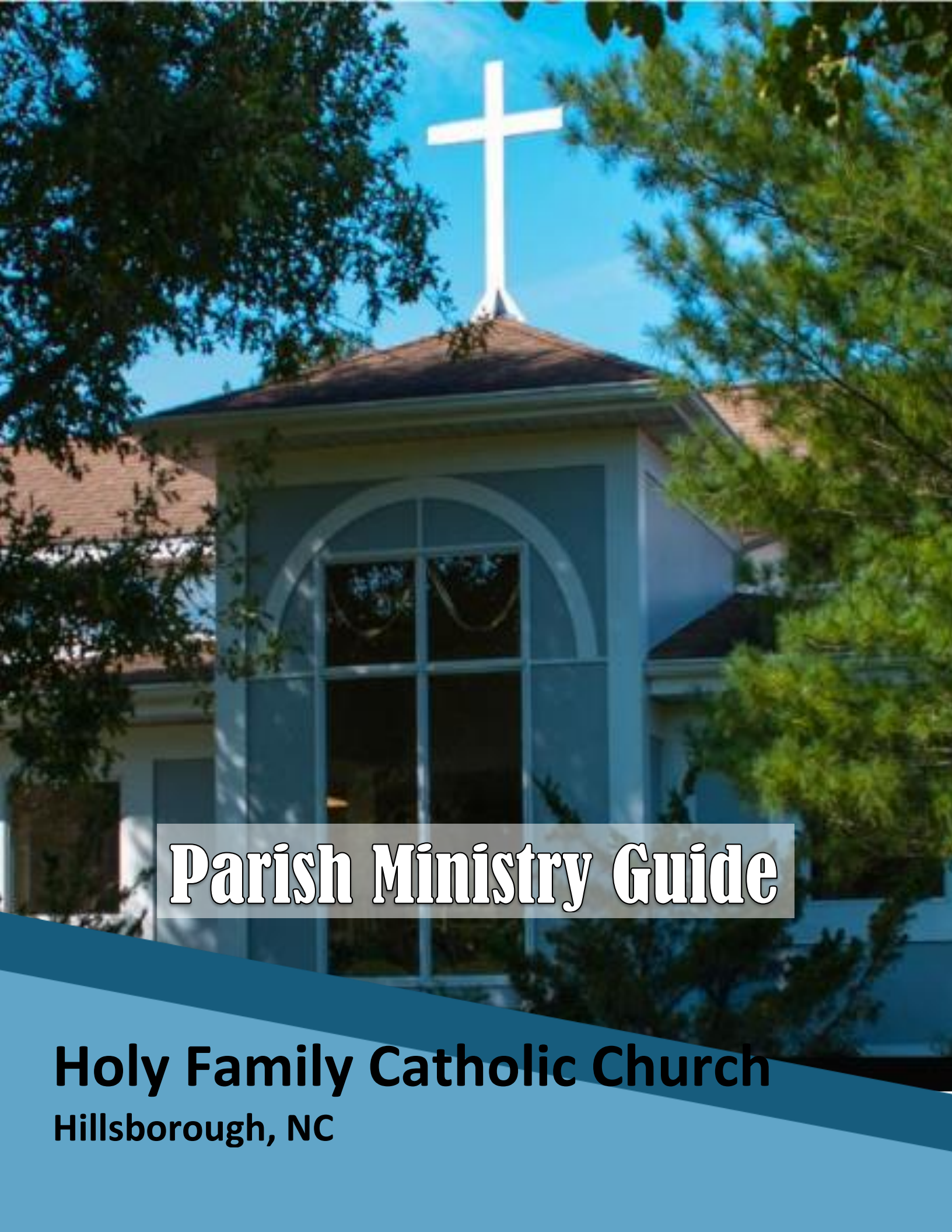

Our Parish Life

We have a wide variety of ministries to get involved with here at Holy Family, and we want to be sure you know what's available to you!
