GIVE CENTRAL

John 14:15-2

The early Christians never felt abandoned by Christ, the Lord. The Church has always been and is the presence of Christ in the world and her members have become the voice, hands, feet and heart of the one who surrendered his life to rescue us from the darkness of death to lead us into the light of eternity. This theme resounds in today's readings, especially in the Gospel. In Christ, we discover the way that leads us to the Holy Spirit, the comforter, who showers us with the strength we need and the truth to set us free, liberating those who suffer from evil. Once again, in the second reading, Saint Peter offers us a clear exhortation about the lifestyle that must characterize a life of faith, always rooted in charity and service, full of hope that never fades. As the Easter season is soon to end, we must ask ourselves if we have entered more deeply into the Paschal Mystery this year, or showed others the love of Christ through lives of service. To conclude this mystogological season, our communities should hold a retreat in which the neophytes, or newly baptized members of the community, may also participate.

 Jesus "suffered for sins once." He was put to death as far as fleshly existence goes but received life according to the spirit.

Gospel John 14:15-2
 Jesus assured the disciples that he would not leave them orphaned but would ask the Father to send "another Advocate" to be with them always. Jesus said that he would still reveal himself to those who love him.

 Christ Jesus, the risen Lord, appeared many times to his disciples. His departing exhortation was that they would soon be baptized with the Holy Spirit to strengthen them in their work.
