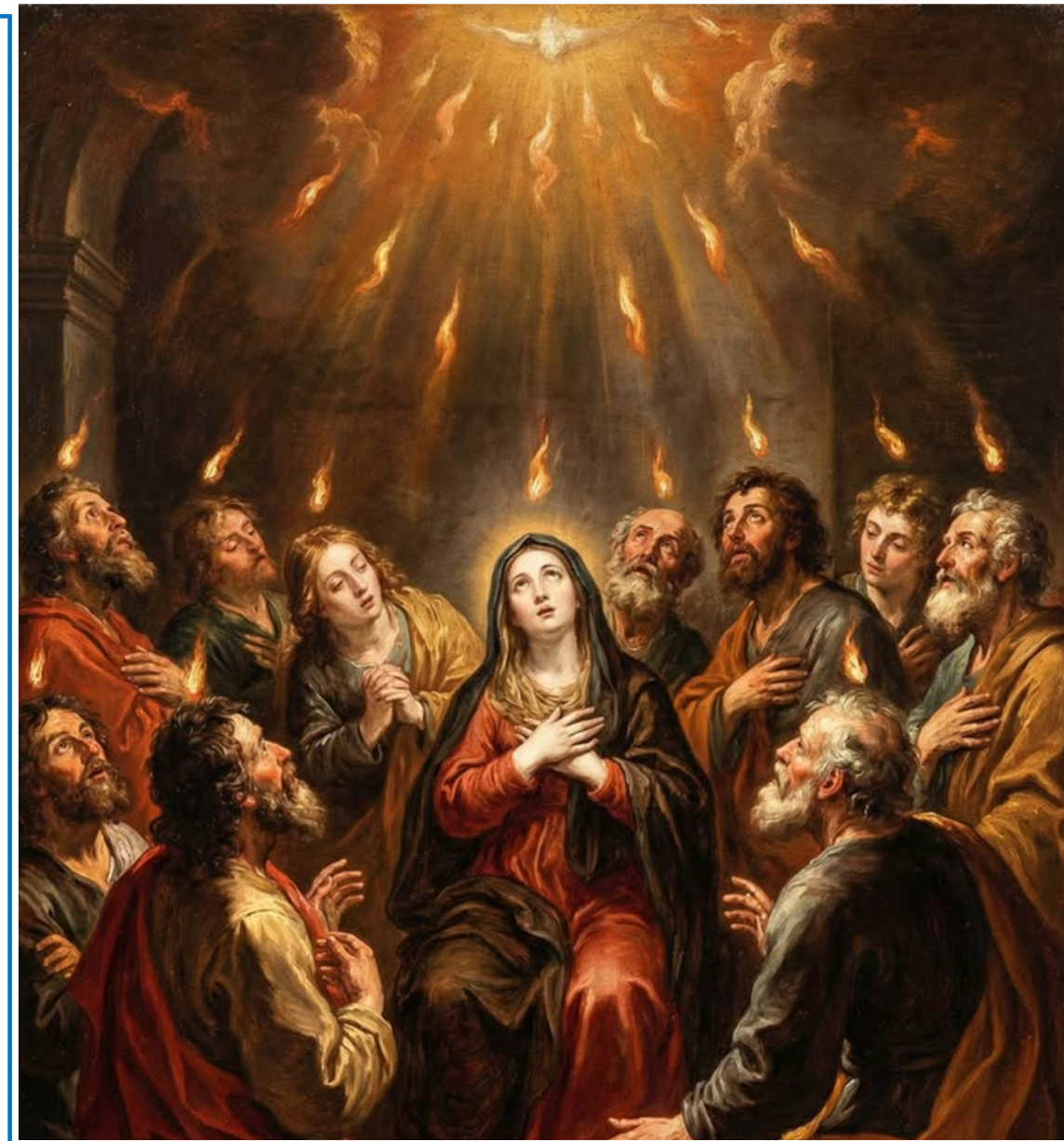

## John 20:19-23

In today's Gospel, the risen Christ appears before his apostles to offer them peace and to assure them of the presence of the Holy Spirit in their lives. With this image, the liturgy of Pentecost seems to capture the elements of the Easter season precisely at the conclusion of the season. If the vigil readings thematically emphasized the world's hunger and thirst for the Holy Spirit, today's readings respond with the impact of the Spirit on those who opened up their hearts to him. The images used in the book of Acts such as tongues of fire and unrecognizable languages refer to the strength of the Spirit in the life of the Christian. The second reading from Paul's first letter to the Corinthians, however, helps us to better understand the presence of the Spirit, who bestows on us different gifts to strengthen the Church and, through baptism, channels our diversity into unity, since "there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone" (1 Corinthians 12:7). At the end of the day today, after Vespers or after the last Mass, the paschal candle is removed from the ambo in procession instead of the cross, and placed near the baptismal font to signal the conclusion of the Easter season.

**Gospel John 3:16-18** God loved the world so greatly that he sent his only Son that all may have eternal life. The Son did not come to condemn the world but that it might be saved through him. Whoever believes in the Lord will live forever.

## PENTECOST VOICE

The Holy Spirit, who came on Pentecost, gave voice to the apostles to proclaim the truth of the Gospel. The Spirit, the Soul of the Church, continues to enable the Church to speak, and enables us to speak in our individual capacity. According to the late Cardinal Elio Sgreccia, who served as President of the Vatican's Pontifical Academy for Life, "The Church must speak out in today's context on fundamental rights, the right to justice, the right to peace, but above all and in the first place, the right to life. If the Church did not speak, did not proclaim the truth, it would be abandoning its duty; it would be unfaithful to society, to the good of society. Therefore, its precise duty is the very liberty to intervene with word, and also with example - - the example of promoting human life, of intervening for the salvation of mankind."
