Matthew 14:13-21

Today's liturgy asks us a rather direct question: **What can truly satisfy us?**
In a society where obesity is common and physical food seems more important than spiritual food, **God's** word provides an answer.

In the Old Testament, **God** presents himself as one who wants to satisfy the hunger and thirst of his people. In the Gospel, **Jesus** wishes to feed a great crowd. Before such blessings, Saint Paul asks, **who or what can separate us from the love of Christ?**

Liturgy committees can help the community reflect on and identify, in today's world, the realities Saint Paul presents as obstacles to **Christ's** love in today's second reading: Tribulation? Anguish? Persecution? Hunger? At the same time, we must ask ourselves: **What keeps us in communion with Christ's love?**

Second Reading Romans 8:35, 37-39 Nothing, not even death, can separate the faithful from the love of God in Christ Jesus.

Gospel Matthew 14:13-21 Huge crowds followed Jesus. He felt compassion for them and healed the sick. He saw that they were hungry and, rather than send them away empty, he gave them bread and fish in abundance.
