THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

"And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel." Mt 2:6

Excerpts from the Lectionary for Mass ©2001, 1998, 1970 CCD.



Matthew 2:1-12

In their thirst for knowledge of God, the wise men from the East willingly left everything, their home and country, in pursuit of that quest. In their diligent search they were led to the source of true knowledge - to Jesus Christ, the Light and Wisdom of God. When they found the newborn King they humbly worshiped him and gave him gifts fitting for a king.

The Lord of the universe who revealed the star of Bethlehem to the Gentiles of the East so they could come and worship Jesus, the Prince of Peace and King of Kings, gives each one of us the same light of revelation to recognize and accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior. Faith is an entirely free gift that God makes to us. It is through the help of the Holy Spirit, who moves the heart and opens the eyes of the mind, that we are able to understand, accept, and believe the truth which God has revealed to us through his Son, Jesus Christ. In faith, the human will and intellect cooperate with grace. "Believing is an act of the intellect assenting to the divine truth by command of the will moved by God through grace"

(Thomas Aquinas).

To know and to encounter Jesus Christ is to know God personally. In the encounter of the wise men with Jesus we see the plan of God to give his only Son as King and Savior, not just for the Jewish people but for all the nations as well. The Lord Jesus came that both Jew and Gentile might find true and lasting peace with God. Let us pray today that Jew and Gentile alike will find the Lord and Savior on their journey of life. Do you bring the light of Jesus Christ to those you meet through the witness of your life and testimony?

Signs of the Savior: Wise Men (Magi)

The Wise man, or Magi, traveled a long distance, guided by the Star of Bethlehem, to find Jesus. They brought gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh, recognizing Jesus as King. The Wise Men teach us about the importance of seeking Jesus and offering our best to him. Their journey shows us that Jesus is for all people, from every nation. Seeing the Wise Men in the Nativity Scene reminds us to be generous and to honor Jesus with our lives and gifts.

Let us pray that praying with the word of God be nourishment for our lives and a source of hope in our communities, helping us to build a more fraternal and missionary Church.



First Reading Isaiah 42:1

"I, the LORD, have called you for the victory of justice, I have grasped you by the hand; I formed you, and set you as a covenant of the people, a light for the nations, to open the eyes of the blind, to bring out prisoners from confinement, and from the dungeon, those who live in darkness.

Responsorial Psalm 29:1-2

Second Reading Acts 10:34

"In truth, I see that God shows no partiality. Rather, in every nation whoever fears him and acts uprightly is acceptable to him.

Gospel Matthew 3:13-17

"After Jesus was baptized, he came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened for him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon him. And a voice came from the heavens, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

6 facts about Epiphany

- 1 Three **Epiphanies** of Jesus' life are celebrated. Epiphany means "manifestation."
- 2 Epiphany has been **celebrated** since the **3rd century** and is one of the **oldest liturgical feasts**.
- 3 The **names of the Magi** do not appear in the Bible and there could have been more than 3.
- 4 St. Augustine said that the Magi from the East arrived on the 13th day of the birth of Jesus: **January 6**.
- 5 Tradition called the Magi "kings" because of **Psalm 72**.
- 6 The **Star of Bethlehem** could have been a conjunction of **Saturn and Jupiter**.

Next Sunday is **The Baptism of the Lord**. Families that have a baby Jesus statue can bring their babies for a blessing. Please be on time for mass so your baby Jesus doesn't miss his blessing.
