Categories – Distance Rules & Notes

The OTC Series features one of the most comprehensive age group structures in the region, with categories running all the way through 75+.

Sizing Down on Course

At Aid Station 1, tell a volunteer you'd like to size down. You'll receive a **GREEN STICKER** on your number plate and be reclassified into the shorter distance category.

Long course riders starting separately receive a **20-minute time penalty** if they switch distances.

Sizing Up

You **MAY NOT** ride a longer distance than registered after the start. Distance upgrades are only available at **packet pickup**.

Each event (except Takelma) features a split at Aid Station 1.

Youth Riders

- **Ages 14–18:** First 50 riders get 30% off — thanks to Bicycle Accident Law!
- **Ages 12–14:** Welcome to race, but a parent must email us first.



Team Competition

Pre-register with a team name to be included in the Team Competition!

In 2026, Adventure Squad took home the win with Perthes Awareness Cycling Team in 2nd and LandShark in 3rd.

Racers DO NOT need to be signed up for the Oregon Triple Crown Series to be included in the Team Competition, but they do need to ride the following courses:

- Real West Gravel LONG Course
- Sasquatch Duro Monster Squatch LONG course
- Oregon Coast Gravel Epic Abomination LONG course
- West Coast Gravel Erik the Red LONG course
- Takelma Gravel Grinder ONLY course
- Bend Dirt Fest LONG course



Team Competition – Rules & Scoring

Team Name Rules

All riders must register with the **EXACT SAME TEAM NAME** at every event — spelling counts. No OBRA registration required. Pre-register by Friday before each event with your team name entered at registration.

How Teams Are Scored

Riders with the same team name who finish the designated course are grouped in sets of 3 by fastest times. Overall Team winner = **best THREE races** out of six events. Podium recognition at each event.

Series Finale

Final Overall podium and Series awards at the last OTC race. The final event features the series raffle and overall awards for all OTC riders.



Volunteers

We are nothing without your support.

Every event we produce runs on the energy and dedication of our volunteers. From the first car in the parking lot to the last rider across the finish line, our volunteers make it all possible.

Sweep Riders

Help ensure no rider is left behind on course. Sweep riders follow the route after the main field, providing support and safety for those finishing later.

The same 1-for-1 discount applies to sweep riders — ride one event as a sweep and receive a complimentary entry to a future event.

Packet Pickup Help

Assist with race morning registration, bib distribution, and getting riders ready to roll. A great way to be part of the energy before the gun goes off.

NEW FOR 2027

Aid Station Crew

Bring your team or club and take on supporting a full aid station with 3 people — and your team or club will receive 3 complimentary entries to that event. A great way to give back and earn your way in! Sign up inside your event registration and contact us after the event for your comp codes.

⚠ Important: Select your volunteer role during registration. Comp codes will be issued after the event — contact us at volunteer@mudslingerevents.com to redeem.



Safety / Rules

All OTC events operate on open roads and land — stay alert, be respectful, and ride within your limits.

⊗ ⚠ **Open Roads — Always.** Cars, trucks, and other vehicles can be coming up any road at any time. Slow down, use caution, and never assume a road is clear. **Rules of the Road apply at all times.**

🛑 Helmet & Visibility

Helmets required AT ALL TIMES — before, during, and after events. Blinking taillights highly recommended. OBRA rules apply. Disqualification may result from non-compliance.

🤝 Be Respectful

The most important rule: BE RESPECTFUL. Courses are open to foot, bike, and vehicle traffic at all times. Follow the rules, show consideration for all road users, and be a good example.

🚗 Ride at Your Own Risk

Gravel cycling is participate-at-your-own-risk. Hazards include terrain, weather, vehicles, and other trail users. Be self-sufficient, stay visible, and always yield to traffic — any vehicle can appear on any road at any moment.



Safety / Rules (cont.)

🚦 On the Road

Stay right when warming up. Use a taillight and bright clothing. Your race does not supersede the safety of any other person on the course.

⚠️ **Rules of the Road apply at ALL times.** Cars, trucks, and other vehicles can appear on any road at any moment. Slow down, use caution, and never assume a road is clear.

📋 Key Rules

- No littering — pack out gel wrappers and trash
- No bad language or attitude
- Use toilets provided — no urinating in view of others
- Pass safely — call out "Coming by" or "On your Left/Right"

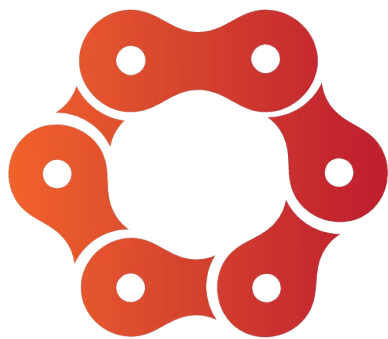
🚨 In an Emergency

Send someone to the nearest checkpoint with the rider's plate number, injury details, and mileage. EMT/911 response may take 30+ minutes. Search and Rescue evacuation may take an additional hour.

RIDE WITHIN YOUR LIMITS.

Limited OBRA insurance applies. Additional accident insurance available through Get Spot — individual monthly plan or OBRA annual membership add-on.

If You're Involved in an Accident with a Vehicle

Knowing what to do after a vehicle accident can protect your health, your rights, and your recovery.

At the Scene

- Stop and stay calm. Do not leave.
- Call 911 — get a police report, even for minor incidents.
- Document everything: photos of the scene, your bike, injuries, the vehicle, and road conditions.
- Get the driver's name, license plate, insurance info, and any witness contacts.
- Do not admit fault or apologize — even casually.

After the Incident

- Seek medical attention immediately, even if you feel okay. Some injuries appear hours or days later.
- Document all injuries, treatment, and time lost from training or racing.
- Keep your damaged bike and gear — do not repair or discard anything. It's evidence.
- Report the crash using Scarborough's crash reporting tool at bicycleaccidentlaw.com — no app download required.

- Water always available.
- Hammer Heed electrolytes.
- Volunteers ready to refill bottles and hydration packs quickly.

Nutrition & Fuel

- Bananas, oranges, pickles, PB&J, chips, cookies, energy bars, gels and more.

Cut-Offs & Timing

- Cutoff times enforced at key stations.
- Volunteers will alert you if you're close to a cutoff.

Leave No Trace

- Pack out what you pack in.
- Drop wrappers at designated bins or with volunteers.

Pro Tips

- Label bottles for quick grab-and-go.
- Thank your volunteers.
- Don't skip the salt — it's the secret weapon on long rides.

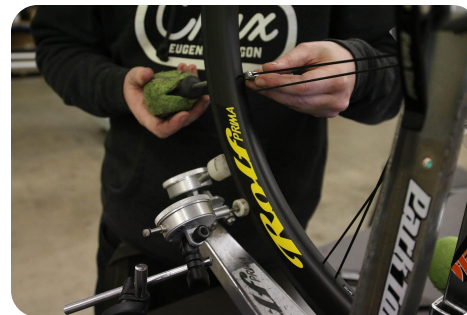
