- 14 Old & Worn Car Seats Turned In



The Numbers - Our three young heroes, Pryor (age 2), Pierce (age 4) & Preston (age 7) = ages at the time of the crash. It is our mission to keep drivers and passengers safe from impaired driving 24 hours/7 days a week. The Dashboard Clock - Shows Movement as we will continue to engage in positive change to prevent drunk, drugged and

distracted driving. **The Hands on the Clock** - Set at 5:52pm., the time that Terri Dillard received a notification on her Life 360 App of a sudden stop of Dustin/Brittany's SUV on Christmas Day, 2022.
