What is Advent?

Beginning the Church's liturgical year, Advent (from, "ad-venire" in Latin or "to come to") is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas. The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and also to the anniversary of the Lord's birth on Christmas Day. The final days of Advent focus particularly on our preparation for the celebrations of the Nativity of our Lord (Christmas). Advent begins this Sunday, 30th November.
