





#### FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) ROLE

#### • Tribal Transit Formula Grants - 5311 (c) (1) (B)

 Provides funding to federally recognized Indian tribes to provide public transportation services on and around Indian reservations or tribal land in rural areas.

#### Funding for:

- Capital
- Operating
- Planning
- administrative expenses

#### • Eligible activities:


- Capital projects → Facilities, wash racks, fuel stations
- Operating costs of equipment → Vehicles, Parts, Labor
- Facilities for use in public transportation → Bus shelters
- Acquisition of public transportation services -> Contracting










## MINNESOTA LOCATION
