



## Montgomery Camper Covenant

Please carefully review the camper covenant with your camper(s) and sign electronically in the registration portal.

I agree to follow the rules listed below during my time at Camp Montgomery:

1. I will treat everyone with kindness and help make Montgomery a welcoming place.
2. I will show respect for all plant and animal life at Montgomery.
3. I will respect the camp property and I will not physically damage or write on any of the Montgomery property.
4. I will show respect and follow the directions of all adults and counselors at camp.
5. I will attend all camp meals, activities, and worship times.
6. I will leave the following at home:
  - a. Food, gum, candy
  - b. Cell phones
  - c. iPods, iPads, tablets, laptop computers, electronic games or devices
  - d. Jewelry or other valuable items
  - e. Weapons, including pocket knives, or items that might be seen as a weapon
7. I will always wear clothing appropriate for Camp, as outlined in the following Dress Code, which is followed by campers, Staff, and Volunteers:
  - a. Clothing should be functional. Tops need to have at least two broad straps. Clothing must cover the entire torso. Clothing should fit well and allow full range of motion.
  - b. Appropriate undergarments must be worn but may not be exposed (i.e., boxer shorts, underwear, bras).
  - c. Articles of clothing which display profanity or slogans which promote tobacco, alcohol, drugs, gangs, violence, sex or are in any other way distracting may not be worn.
  - d. Shoes and socks will be worn at all times except in lake areas. Shoe laces and/or straps must be secured at all times. Crocs may be worn if they have the strap in place at the heel ("Adventure Mode").
  - e. Swimsuits should be **functional** and remain in place during water activities. One piece swimsuits or tankinis are recommended and preferred.
8. I understand that I could be sent home for the following:
  - a. Fighting
  - b. Harassing, hurting or teasing others
  - c. Stealing
  - d. Destroying property

- e. Using foul language or gestures
  - f. Being involved with pranks or cabin raids
  - g. Failure to obey or be respectful to my counselors, camp leaders or others at camp in charge of my care
  - h. Wandering away from my group
  - i. Anything that is seen as unsafe to others or myself
9. I understand that any care packages sent to camp should not include food items.

I have read and thought about all of these points and agree to abide by this agreement during my stay at camp. Montgomery Center reserves the right to dismiss, without refund, any camper or staff member whose influence is considered detrimental to the overall camp program.
