Lenten Regulations:

Fasting: (18-59) are required to fast on **Ash Wed.** and **Good Friday.** Fasting means eating one full meal, plus two smaller meals that don't equal a full meal.

Abstaining from meat: all Catholics 14 & older are required to avoid meat and anything made with meat on Ash Wed. and all Fridays of Lent.
