# Advent: a period of devout and joyful expectation

The theme of readings and teachings during Advent is often to prepare for the Second Coming while commemorating the First Coming of Christ at Christmas. With the view of directing the thought of Christians to the first coming of Jesus Christ as savior and to his Second Coming as judge, special readings are prescribed for each of the four Sundays in Advent. "The Gloria is omitted from the Mass so that on Christmas night, the song of the angels may ring out anew in all its freshness." The usual liturgical color for Advent is purple. Purple reminds us of the spirit of prayer and preparatory sacrifices we make during the Advent Season.

# **Food for thought:**

As the first word of Advent, Christ tells us, "Stay awake! You must be prepared." The unprepared people "in the days of Noah" were distracted by their "eating and drinking," oblivious to the imminent flood. In what does advent preparations consist? Putting on the Lord Jesus Christ through faith. "Encountering Christ, letting [ourselves] be caught up in and guided by His love, enlarges the horizons of existence, gives it a firm hope which will not disappoint. Faith is no refuge for the fainthearted, but something which enhances our lives. It makes us aware of a magnificent calling, the vocation of love...Faith is a lamp which guides our steps in the night and suffices for the journey" (Lumen Fidei,53). "Let us walk in the light of the Lord!"
