Former President Donald Trump promised (Feb. 22) that he would make a triumphant return to the White House next year and that he would restore Christian preachers to power in American culture.

"If I get in, you're going to be using that **power at a level that you've never used before**," Trump told the annual gathering of National Religious Broadcasters. He described himself as a friend and fellow believer and someone **ready to restore God to his rightful place in American culture**. "With your help and God's grace, **the great revival of America begins on November 5th**," he said. Trump portrayed evangelical Christians as a persecuted group under President Joe Biden's administration. He told the religious broadcasters that one of his first acts of a second Trump term would be to set up **a task force to root out "anti-Christian bias."**

Though he admitted that he wasn't a very good Christian and didn't know much about the Bible, Trump told broadcasters that he shared their faith and would always stand up for God — lines that brought thunderous applause. But Trump's biggest applause lines came when he promised to promote school vouchers, seal the United States' Southern border and prevent transgender men from participating in women's sports. With him as president, he vowed that America would have only two genders — male and female.... He claimed that "bad things" were being done to Christian crosses, another thing that would stop if he became president again. And he would work to reverse the decline of organized religion and church-going in America. "We have to bring back our religion," he said. **"We have to bring back Christianity."** Kevin Roberts, president of the Heritage Foundation, also spoke before Trump took the stage. Roberts dismissed concerns expressed by Trump's foes about corruption and authoritarianism if the former president returns to office.

[Trump's speech at this event stirred up many Adventists all around the world. They heard in his words the rumblings of the long-awaited "image of the beast" church/state system by the lamblike two-horned beast—apostate Protestantism. Trump promised to give civil power to the evangelicals "like they never used before." He promised to "reverse the decline of church-going in America," and that could only mean the use of civil power to force people to worship on Sunday. Trump called

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this union of the state with the —*Cont. from Previous Column* church a "revival" that would start with his election! He wants to restore God to His rightful place in American culture. Is this a spiritual, or political revival? Finally, Trump said he would set up **a task force to root out "anti-Christian bias."** What would this task force be? How would it "root out"? We will no doubt find out! **THE END**

WHAT IS THE IMAGE TO THE BEAST?

What is the "image to the beast"? and how is it to be formed? The image is made by the two-horned beast, and is an image to the beast. It is also called an image of the beast.

Then to learn what the image is like and how it is to be formed we must study the characteristics of the beast itself—the papacy.

When the early church became corrupted by departing from the simplicity of the gospel and **accepting heathen rites and customs, she lost the Spirit and power of God**; [EDITORS: This happened in 1955-56 when the SDA church accepted the false doctrines of 1) the Trinity; 2) Christ coming in immaculate flesh of Adam before the fall; and 3) the Atonement finished at the cross.] and in order to control the consciences of the people, she sought the support of the secular power. The result was the papacy, a church that **controlled the power of the state** [See ADRA funds in Zimbabwe. p. 8.] and employed it to further her own ends, especially for the punishment of "heresy." In order for **the United States to form an image of the beast, the religious power must so control the civil government that the authority of the state will also be employed by the church to accomplish her own ends.**

Whenever the church has obtained secular power, she has employed it to **punish dissent** from her doctrines. Protestant churches that have followed in the steps of Rome by forming alliance with worldly powers have manifested a similar desire to restrict liberty of conscience. An example of this is given in the long-continued persecution of dissenters by the Church of England. During the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, thousands of nonconformist ministers were forced to flee from their churches, and many, both of pastors and people, were subjected to fine, imprisonment, torture, and martyrdom.

It was apostasy that led the early church to seek the aid of the civil government, and this prepared the way for the development of the papacy—the beast. Said Paul: "There" shall "come a falling away, . . . and that man of

sin be revealed." 2 Thessalonians 2:3. **So apostasy in the church will prepare the way for the image to the beast.**

The Bible declares that before the coming of the Lord there will exist a state of religious declension similar to that in the first centuries. "In the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, high-minded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof." 2 Timothy 3:1-5. "Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils." 1 Timothy 4:1. Satan will work "with all power and signs and lying wonders, and with all deceivableness of unrighteousness." And all that "received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved," will be left to accept "strong delusion, that they should believe a lie." 2 Thessalonians 2:9-11. When this state of ungodliness shall be reached, the same results will follow as in the first centuries.

The wide diversity of belief in the Protestant churches is regarded by many as decisive proof that no effort to secure a forced uniformity can ever be made. But there has been for years, in churches of the Protestant faith, **a strong and growing sentiment in favor of a union based upon common points of doctrine.** To secure such a union, the discussion of subjects upon which all were not agreed—however important they might be from a Bible standpoint—**must necessarily be waived.**

Charles Beecher, in a sermon in the year 1846, declared that the ministry of "the evangelical Protestant denominations" is "not only formed all the way up under a tremendous pressure of merely human fear, but they live, and move, and breathe in a state of things radically corrupt, and appealing every hour to every baser element of their nature to hush up the truth, and bow the knee to the power of apostasy. Was not this the way things went with Rome? Are we not living her life over again? And what do we see just ahead? Another general council! A world's convention! Evangelical alliance, and universal creed!"—Sermon on "The Bible a Sufficient Creed," delivered at Fort Wayne, Indiana, Feb. 22, 1846. When this shall be gained, then, in the effort to secure complete uniformity, it will be only a step **to the resort to force.**

When the leading churches of the United States, uniting upon such points of doctrine as are held by them in common, shall influence the state to enforce their decrees and to sustain their institutions, then Protestant America **will have formed an image of the Roman hierarchy,** and the infliction of civil penalties upon dissenters will inevitably result.

The beast with two horns "causeth [commands] all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond,

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to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: and that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name." Revelation 13:16, 17. The third angel's warning is: "If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, the same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God." "The beast" mentioned in this message, whose worship is enforced by the two-horned beast, is the first, or leopardlike beast of Revelation 13 -- the papacy. The "image to the beast" represents that form of apostate Protestantism which will be developed when the Protestant churches shall seek the aid of the civil power for the enforcement of their dogmas.

After the warning against the worship of the beast and his image the prophecy declares: "Here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus." Since those who keep God's commandments are thus placed in contrast with those that worship the beast and his image and receive his mark, **it follows that the keeping of God's law, on the one hand, and its violation, on the other, will make the distinction between the worshipers of God and the worshipers of the beast.**

The special characteristic of the beast, and therefore of his image, is the breaking of God's commandments. Says Daniel, of the little horn, the papacy: "He shall think to change times and the law." Daniel 7:25, R.V. And Paul styled the same power the "man of sin," who was to exalt himself above God. One prophecy is a complement of the other. **Only by changing God's law could the papacy exalt itself above God;** whoever should understandingly keep the law as thus changed would be giving supreme honor to that power by which the change was made. Such an act of obedience to papal laws would be **a mark** of allegiance to the pope in the place of God.

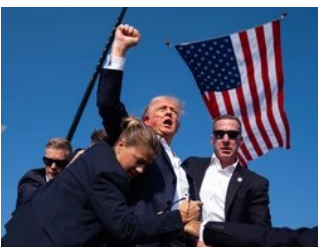

THE GOP VISION FOR AMERICA

The connection between Republican voters and their leaders was never primarily about abortion. Rather, as Trump's "Make America Great Again" (MAGA) transformation of the party reveals, Trump's bond with his supporters is forged from different material: namely, his militant **mission** to return power to white Christian America.

Trump instinctively understands this reality. In contrast to his vacillation on abortion, Trump's rallies are filled with evocations of an idealized ethno-religious state that are articulate, energetic, and consistent. ...One of Trump's early re-election campaign stops was the annual meeting of the National Religious Broadcasters in Nashville on February 22, attended by leaders of the largest white evangelical communications outlets. In his rambling 75-minute speech to these Christian Right leaders, Trump spent a scant two minutes talking about abortion. ...The beating heart of the speech was the projection of a white Christian nationalist **vision**. Trump told the enthusiastic crowd—many of whom sported red hats emblazoned with the words "Make America Pray Again"—that he knew they were "under siege." He declared that one of his first acts of his second term would be to set up **a task force to root out** "anti-Christian bias" and pledged to protect "pro-God context and content." He received spontaneous applause for vows to promote school vouchers for private Christian schools and seal the United States' southern border against "an illegal alien invasion by the world's most sadistic criminals and savage gangs." ...After he narrowly survived an assassination attempt in August, Trump mused that he was only alive because of divine intervention, making this messianic comparison quite literal.



Notably, his promises to the evangelical broadcasters extended beyond the realm of policy: "If I get in, you're going to be using that power at a level that you've never used before." He continued: "I really believe it's the biggest thing missing from this country, the biggest thing missing. We have to bring back **our religion**. We have to bring back Christianity in this country." Trump's deployment of the term "our religion"—one he regularly rolls out when addressing predominantly white evangelical audiences—is transparently an affirmation of an America of, by, and for white conservative Christians. This worldview, most frequently referred to as white Christian nationalism today, is an old one, predating the founding of our nation. It flows directly from the 500-year-old Christian Doctrine of Discovery—the idea that America was designated by God to be a promised land for European Christians—which justified the settler colonial

ancient headwaters of our nation's history.



- * God has called Christians to exercise dominion over all areas of American society.
- * The US government should declare America a Christian nation.

* Being Christian is an important part of being truly American.

* If the US moves away from our Christian foundations, we will not have a country anymore.

* US laws should be based on Christian values.

...Today, a majority of Republicans (55%)—and fully two thirds (66%) of white evangelicals, the religious base of the GOP—qualify as Christian nationalist Adherents or Sympathizers (those who either fully or mostly agree with these five statements). Why should we be worried about this? ...Most ominously, Christian nationalists are more likely than other Americans to think about politics in apocalyptic terms and are about twice as likely as other Americans to believe political violence may be justified in our current circumstances. Nearly 4 in 10 Christian nationalism Adherents (38%) and one-third of Sympathizers (33%) agree that "Because things have gotten so far off track, true American patriots may have to resort to violence to save the country," compared with only 17% of Christian nationalism Skeptics and 7% of Rejecters. And support for political violence among Christian nationalists is hardening.

The **worldview** of white Christian nationalism raises the stakes of political contests exponentially, transposing political opponents into existential enemies. Politics are no longer understood to be honest disagreements between fellow citizens but rather apocalyptic battles over good and evil, literally fought by agents of God against agents of Satan. From these illiberal assumptions, it easily follows that political rivals should not just be defeated in fair electoral contests; they should be jailed, exiled, or even killed.

[EDITORS: This describes the way our world is tending today, which is as Jesus predicted: "They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service. And these things will they do unto you, because they have not known the Father, nor me." **John 16:2,3.**

Remember, Jesus said, "Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord. Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head. **Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.**" **Romans 12:19-21.]** THE END

THE GOAL OF THE COMMISSION

Extracts from Executive Order 14291—
Establishment of the Religious Liberty Commission

President Trump celebrated the annual National Day of Prayer on May 1 by announcing an Executive Order to establish the Religious Liberty Commission.

"The Commission shall produce a comprehensive report on
***The Foundations of Religious Liberty in America,**
***The Impact of religious liberty on American society,**
***Current Threats to domestic religious liberty,**
***Strategies to preserve and enhance religious**
liberty protections for future generations, and
***Programs to increase awareness of and celebrate**
America's peaceful religious pluralism.

Specific topics to be considered by the Commission under these categories shall include the following areas:

- 1) the First Amendment rights of pastors, religious leaders, houses of worship, faith-based institutions, and religious speakers;**
- 2) attacks across America on houses of worship of many religions;**
- 3)debanking of religious entities;**
- 4) the First Amendment rights of teachers, students, military chaplains, service members, employers, and employees;**
- 5) conscience protections in the health care field and concerning vaccine mandates;**
- 6) parents' authority to direct the care, upbringing, and education of their children, including the right to choose a religious education;**
- 7) permitting time for voluntary prayer and religious instruction at public schools;**
- 8) Government displays with religious imagery;**
- 9) and the right of all Americans to freely exercise their faith without fear or Government censorship or retaliation."**

[EDITORS: The Religious Liberty Commission comes onto the scene a little late. In many state religious schools already are receiving state **educational vouchers**. These include SDA, Protestant, Muslim, Hindu, and Roman Catholic schools. The bulk of the money, about 2/3, is funding Roman Catholic schools, the biggest parochial school system. These schools are already part of a church/state system, which is **totally against** the U.S. Constitution in practice. The voucher system makes the church schools dependent on the state. That's a church/state system already.

Notice goal #7—"Permitting time for voluntary prayer and religious instruction at public schools." Time for voluntary prayer is not needed. Any student can send a quick prayer up to God without notice as Nehemiah did as he served the king. Religious instruction should be done in the home. If it was done in public schools, the priests should not come near, due to their notorious record with children across America. Then, too, there is the fact that they represent a church/state system diametrically opposed to the Constitution.]

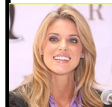

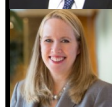

FIRST RELIGIOUS LIBERTY COMM. MEETING

The first meeting of the Religious Liberty Commission, a project of the United States Department of Justice, held at the Museum of the Bible on June 16,

2025. Texas Lt. Gov. Dan Patrick chaired the inaugural meeting of the Presidential Commission on Religious Liberty last Monday at the Museum of the Bible in Washington, D.C. U.S. Attorney General Pam Bondi also addressed the commission, saying, “Our Founding Fathers understood that every individual must be free to worship without fear, without coercion, and without government interference.”

Witnesses, including **Mark Rienzi**, a professor at The Catholic University of America, Columbus School of Law, and Notre Dame law professor **Gerald Bradley**, provided testimony on the historical and legal significance of religious freedom, highlighting its roots in the founding era and challenges posed by modern judicial interpretations. Paula White-Cain, ...appointed to lead the White House Faith Office earlier this year, warned: ... “Employees have been fired over their faith. Religious entities have been de-banked, parental rights have been violated,” she said. “Who would have ever thought that in the very beginning, President Trump would have to pardon 23 pro-lifers for standing outside of an abortion clinic and praying silently?” **[They were blocking the entrance.]**

In response to the meeting, the secular group Americans United for Separation of Church and State claimed that the commission’s true “goal is to promote Christian nationalism, not true religious liberty.” Americans United CEO Rachel Laser, who attended the meeting, criticized the decision to hold it at

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the Museum of the Bible and accused the government of catering to “white Christians. It’s clear this commission was created to advance the myth that the United States was founded for white Christians and that our laws and policies must continue to favor their beliefs,” Laser argued.

The commission plans to hold as many as nine hearings through 2026.... **Americans have an opportunity to submit public comments to Commission members prior to each meeting. ZIMBABWEAN ADRA LEADERS EMBEZZLE \$1,500,000

Two Adventist Development & Relief Agency (ADRA) employees of the Zimbabwe division have allegedly embezzled US\$ 1.4 million. Fortune Goredema was brought before Harare regional magistrate ...on fraud charges. He was released on \$1,000 bail under strict conditions.... He has also had to surrender his passport and the title deed to his house. According to other reports, **Judith Musvosvi**, the country director for ADRA Zimbabwe since 2013, not only knew about the scheme but facilitated some of the illegal payments. The Zimbabwean states... **She fled the country** after Goredema's arrest. Claiming to leave town for her niece's wedding, the 65-year-old left for South Africa by bus before heading to Romania.... The fraud was discovered thanks to anonymous whistleblowers in July 2024. ...In total, **US\$1,488,404** was embezzled from ADRA. Thus far, none of the funds have been recovered.

Now as our citizenship ...is in heaven, what has any citizen of heaven ...rightly to do with the political or governmental affairs of any other government? ...As the Christian's citizenship is in heaven, that itself, the very principle of it, prohibits him from taking part in any of the political concerns of any other government, even though it be the government of the United States.

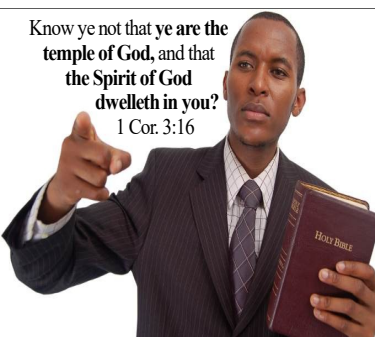
... 2Corinthians 5:20: "Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you In Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God." ... So then, "we are ambassadors for Christ." An ambassador is one sent, and accredited by one government as the representative of that government to another country. Now the principle of ambassadorship prohibits him from any interference whatever with the political concerns of the government to which he is accredited. ... These church leaders who are building up **the beast and his image** profess to stand in the place of, and profess to be, ambassadors for Christ; yet they ...violate the first, the last, and every principle that is involved in ambassadorship. ...

And our preaching the message and the warning **against the worship of the beast and his image**, against the evils which are simply **the result** of the violation of the principles **here laid down**—our opposition to that, our warning against it, must be one of principle....

John 18:36:—"My kingdom is **not of this world**: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants —*Continue next column*

fight."... Then the man who fights *From left column below—* for a kingdom of this world, who contends for supremacy and power in the kingdom of this world, and works for a place in a kingdom of this world, **denies** his connection with the kingdom of Jesus Christ, for His kingdom is **not of this world**....

...Eph.5:8: "YE were sometimes darkness." When? Why, when we were subject to "the rulers of the darkness of this world," when we were in sin. "For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: **walk as children of light**; proving what is acceptable unto the Lord." Governments, nations, political organizations are of this world only; they belong to this world only. "Darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people." But he who is translated out of darkness, delivered from that darkness and translated into the kingdom of God's dear Son, ...is connected with another world; ... the heavenly world; ...There is his citizenship - in the dominion and the world of light.



Thus the work of the beast and his image is **violative** of the principle of citizenship of the kingdom of God; **violative** of the principle of ambassadorship of Jesus Christ; **violative** of the principle of his that separates the government of God from the governments of this earth - that separates between light and darkness. It is simply an attempt **to blend** light and darkness, and is always and only darkness; because it ...will seek **to blend** the government of light with the governments of darkness (church and state).
