

The Church is decorated in green, the color of growing plants. This marks the season of growth in living in our Baptism and receiving the Lord's Word and Sacraments.

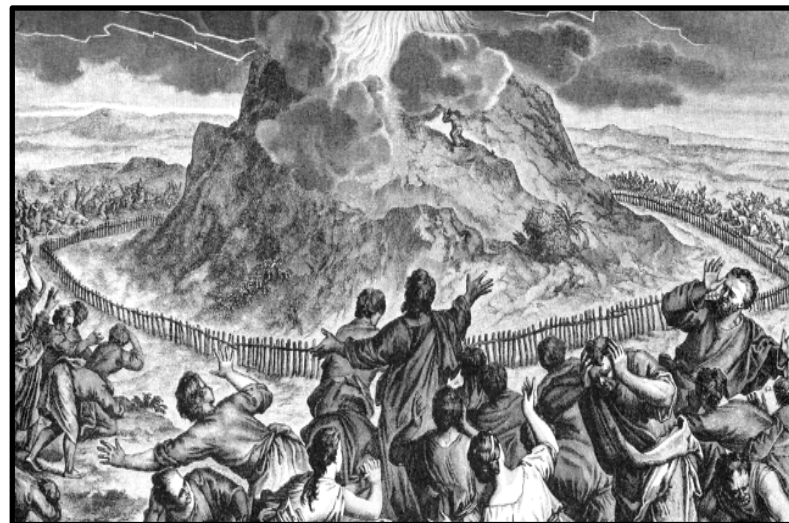
