



Ash Wednesday is this Wednesday. We begin the Lenten season with our Ash Wednesday service with Holy Communion at 7 PM. Midweek services begin the next week with services every Wednesday night at 7 PM. This year, there will be NO Lenten Suppers at 6 PM. Our Lenten theme this year is “Our Savior’s Wounded Body.” We see each week how our Lord Jesus was wounded on His body so that those wounds would heal us of our infirmity, sin.

The Feast of the Transfiguration, celebrated on the last Sunday in the Epiphany season, is a significant and uniquely Lutheran contribution to the Christian calendar. This festival commemorates the moment on the Mount of Transfiguration when three of Jesus’ disciples glimpse their Lord in divine splendor, seeing Him as the center of the Law (Moses) and the prophets (Elijah). Jesus proclaims to His disciples, then and now, that He is the long-awaited one who has come to die for the sins of the world and be raised again in glory.

The Transfiguration of Our Lord is the last Sunday before Lent. Because we give up singing *Alleluia* during Lent, at the close of the service on Transfiguration Sunday, we say farewell to *Alleluia* with the hymn, “Alleluia, Song of Gladness.”
