



<u>CONTEST DESCRIPTION AND TIMING:</u> KCEP-FM and the College Savings Division at the Nevada State Treasurer's Office have partnered to host the Nevada Middle School 2024 Essay Contests

(the "Contests") featuring 4 essay contests that will be offered throughout 2024. Contests will open in February, May, September, and November and close at the end of each month listed (the "Contest Period"), with each having a different topic/theme:

February 2024: The contest begins on 02/01/2024 and ends on 02/29/2024. **May 2024:** The contest begins on 05/01/2024 and ends on 05/31/2024.

September 2024: The contest begins on 09/01/2024 and ends on 09/30/2024. **November 2024:** The contest begins on 11/01/2024 and ends on 11/30/2024.

For the Contest, Nevada students who meet the eligibility requirements are asked to compose an original essay of no longer than 250 words on the theme for the month they are participating in (see page 2 for more details) and submit the Official Essay Entry Form for a chance to win up to \$1,000 towards a Nevada Sponsored 529 account for the benefit of the student. There will be a total of three contest winners. The 3rd place winner will receive a \$250 scholarship in the form of a Nevada Sponsored 529 account. The 2nd place winner will receive a \$500 scholarship in the form of a Nevada Sponsored 529 account. The 1st place winner will receive a \$1,000 scholarship in the form of a Nevada Sponsored 529 Account.

ELIGIBILITY: The Contest is open only to students enrolled in the 6th, 7th, or 8th grade attending a public, private, religious, charter or home school located within the State of Nevada. Immediate family members of Nevada State Treasurer's Office, College Savings Division, and KCEP-FM employees are not eligible. Immediate family means spouses, parents, children, siblings, and stepparents/children, siblings, currently living in the same home or residing at separate residences.





SUBMISSION GUIDELINES: To enter the Contest, student entrants ("Entrants") must -

1) COMPOSE AN ORIGINAL ESSAY OF 250 WORDS OR LESS ON THE TOPIC RELATIVE TO THE CONTEST THE STUDENT IS PARTICIPATING IN:

February 2024: Describe an African American hero who has been influential in history, our community, or in the culture. **May 2024:** Describe an Asian American or Pacific Islander hero who has been influential in history, our community, or in the culture.

September 2024: Describe a Hispanic hero who has been influential in history, our community, or in the culture.

November 2024: Describe a Native American hero who has been influential in history, our community, or in the culture.

2) FORMATTING OF ESSAY:

- 1. Essay must be in English only.
- 2. Essay must be typed using 12pt Times New Roman font; handwritten essays will be automatically disqualified.
- 3. Essay must include a title on the top right corner.
- 4. The Entrant's first and last name must be on the top right corner listed below the title.
- 5. Essay must be double spaced.
- 6. File must be a PDF if submitting via e-mail.
- 7. Essay must properly cite any sources on a separate page to avoid plagiarism.
- 3) COMPLETE OFFICIAL ESSAY ENTRY FORM: Complete Official Essay Entry Form available at https://www.power88lv.com/essay-contest/. Official Essay Entry Form must be completed and signed by Entrant's parent or legal guardian prior to submission. Official Essay Entry Form must be attached to the essay when submitting.

All Entries must be emailed by no later than 5:00pm PST on 02/29/2024, 05/31/2024, 09/30/2024, OR 11/30/2024or postmarked by no later than 02/29/2024, 05/31/2024, 09/30/2024, OR 11/30/2024, depending on the contest/month the student is participating in. Sponsor is not responsible for late, lost, misdirected, damaged, or postage-due Entries, or for late Entries due to computer and/or downloading problems. All Entries become the property of KCEP-FM and the Office of the State Treasurer and will not be returned to the Entrants.





LIMIT: One (1) Entry per student during the Contest period. In the event more than one (1) Entry is received from any one (1) student, the first Entry processed will be considered the only valid Entry received and subsequent Entries from the same student will be disqualified. Winners may only win once in any of the 4 Essay Contests sponsored by radio station KCEP-FM and that State Treasurer's Office.

<u>WINNER SELECTION/VERIFICATION</u>: Winners will be selected by a panel of judges. Essays will be initially screened by radio KCEP-FM. Any incomplete submissions will be disqualified. Submitted essays will be judged on the following criteria: word count, adherence to the topic, spelling/punctuation/grammar, and originality. A maximum of five points will be awarded to each of the four judging categories: word count, adherence to the topic, quality of writing, and originality. The maximum score is 20.

1 point = Less Satisfactory

2 points = Satisfactory

3 points = Good

4 points = Very Good

5 points = Excellent

Adherence to the Topic:

- Exhibits creativity. The Entrant clearly expresses the contest topic in a unique and creative interpretation and style.
- The Entrant expresses the personal meaning or value of the topic.
- The Entrant expressed the topic in a way that draws in the audience.

Quality of Writing:

- Clarity: The Essay has a clear introduction, body, and conclusion.
- Grammar: The Entrant uses proper spelling and punctuation throughout the Essay.
- Formatting: The Entrant meets the formatting requirements. (See Submission Guidelines)

Originality:

- Authenticity
- Unique Perspective

Word Count:

• The Essay stays within the word count of 250 words or less, not including their name and or Title of their Essay.

There will be a First, Second, and Third Place Winner for each of the four Nevada Middle School 2024 Essay Contests: Contest judges have been predetermined.





PRIZES / APPROXIMATE RETAIL VALUE (ARV): One (1) First, Second, and Third Place prizes will be awarded to the selected winners. The prize will be in the form of a Nevada sponsored 529 account for the benefit of the winning child. The First Place Winner will receive \$1,000 deposited into a Nevada sponsored 529 account. The Second Place Winner will receive \$500 deposited into a Nevada sponsored 529 account. The Third Place Winner will receive \$250 deposited into a Nevada sponsored account. The parent or legal guardian will be listed as the owner of the account and will be required to fill out the necessary paperwork in order to claim the prize. The winner and the parent or legal guardian of the winner will be invited to a media event to announce the winners of the Nevada Middle School 2024 Essay Contests. The parent or legal guardian of the winner will be required to complete, execute, and return within 14 business days of being notified, an Affidavit of Eligibility, Publicity Release, and completed 529 application, or the prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner.

GENERAL PRIZE RESTRICTIONS: The parent or legal guardian of each student winner (Nevada sponsored 529 account) will be responsible for all federal, state, and local taxes applicable to acceptance and use of the prize, including income taxes, if any, and will be required to provide his/her Social Security Number or Federal Taxpayer Identification Number for tax reporting purposes. Any and all costs associated with acceptance and use of the prize will be the sole responsibility of the winner. Sponsor will file an IRS Form 1099 with the Internal Revenue Service for the fair market value of prize. No transfer or substitution of the prize permitted, except by Sponsors who reserve the right to substitute the prize, in whole or in part, for one of comparable or greater value. The winner/parent or legal guardian must establish and a qualifying Nevada sponsored 529 account and provide the account number to Nevada State Treasurer's Office, College Savings Division within 14 days of contest completion. Failure to provide the information, will result in forfeiture of the scholarship or prize. The winner/parent or legal guardian should consider the investment objectives, risks, charges, and expenses before investing in a Nevada Sponsored 529 plan. Funds in the plan are neither insured nor guaranteed and there is the risk of investment loss. Please visit www.NVigate.gov to find out more information about investments options.

AGREEMENT TO THE OFFICIAL RULES: By participating in the Contest, each Entrant and Entrant's parent or legal guardian fully and unconditionally agrees to and accepts these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsors and Administrators and the judges, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Contest.

RELEASE: By participating, Entrants and their parents or legal guardians agree to release and hold harmless the Sponsors, and Sponsor's respective trustees, directors, officers, agents, affiliates, and employees (collectively, "Released Parties") from any and all liability for any claims, costs, injuries, losses, or damages of any kind caused by their participation in the Contest, including, but not limited to, the unauthorized or illegal access to personally identifiable or sensitive information. All Entries become the property of the Sponsor and will not be acknowledged nor returned under any circumstances. Upon request of Sponsor, Entrant will provide an Affidavit of Eligibility, Publicity Release, and 529 account information as required above. The winner will grant to Sponsor and its designees the right, except where prohibited by law, to use their and the child's name, age, grade, likenesses, pictures, addresses (cities and states), voices, biographical information, written or oral statements, for advertising, promotional, and online voting purposes in promoting the Sponsor, its products, websites, and/or this Contest or succeeding Contest, in any and all media now or hereafter known throughout the world in perpetuity, without additional compensation, notification, or permission. Entries not complying with all rules are subject to disqualification.

VIOLATIONS: Sponsor may, in its sole determination, disqualify anyone it believes has not complied with the Rules, may be tampering, or acting in a non-sportsmanlike, disruptive, abusive, harassing, or threatening manner.

CHANGES: Sponsor may, in its sole determination, cancel or modify any aspect of the Contest or Rules for any reason which the Sponsor, in its sole opinion, deems affects the Contest, execution or administration of the Contest (whether tampering, technical, or human error, application of new or existing laws/regulations, or other issues).
