The Peer Support Worker provides one on one and group support in a residential setting, while providing a safe, trauma informed and bi-cultural environment of recovery and support.

- Personal experience in recovery from addiction challenges and ability to draw upon wellness and recovery experience
- Peer support related training is a strong asset
- Knowledge in harm reduction principles is an asset
- Social Service/Health Care College Certificate and/or training; or an equivalent combination of education and experience required
