- <u>Request a date for a Baptism Prep Class.</u> Classes 6:30-7pm. Your attendance is necessary at one of the sessions *before* the baptism. In the class, you will meet with others who have made this decision also. During class, the pastor will answer any questions you may have, plus cover important information concerning baptisms. (*Note: You may attend a class <u>before</u> your expectant child's birth*).

## **GUIDELINES FOR BAPTISM DAY**

- Parents & Sponsor(s) should arrive at church <u>20 minutes prior</u> to the start of the worship service.
- Parents and sponsor(s) should go directly to the front of the Sanctuary before the service to meet with Pastor for instructions pertaining to the service itself.
- Seating will be reserved for you and your family in the front rows of one of the seating sections in the Sanctuary.
- We ask that there be NO flash photography during the service. You can gather <u>after</u> the service to pose for pictures by the Baptismal Font. <u>Please notify relatives of this policy</u>. Recording with a phone is allowed from a <u>seated</u> position in a front row seat.
- After the service, be sure to take the following home with you: your **Faith Chest, all certificates, baptismal napkin, and baptismal candle with box.**
