I can't believe that it is that time of year again! This weekend brings one of those small but welcome seasonal shifts—Daylight Savings Time ends on Sunday, which means we all get to "fall back" one hour. While gaining an extra hour of rest is always appreciated, it also serves as a good reminder: Sometimes the most spiritual thing we can do is slow down, breathe, and receive God's gift of rest. As we turn the clocks back, I invite you to also take a step back spiritually—to reflect on where God is moving in your life, in your family, and in our church. This Sunday we will continue in our sermon series called Family Values—a biblical look at what it means to build a Christ-centered home in a world full of competing influences.
