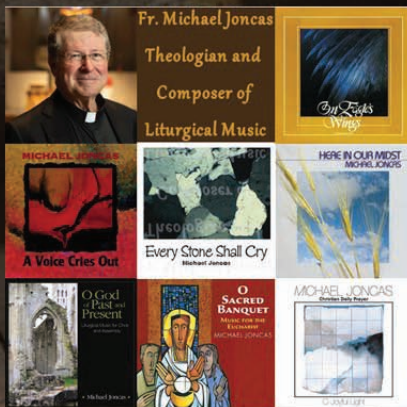

While with the Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette, he served as the director of the La Salette Shrine in Massachusetts, a retreat master in Connecticut and as a psychologist for various counseling centers in New England. Now retired, he enjoys genealogy research, reading Scripture and golf.
