This weekend we welcome Fr. Tulio Ramirez, MXY. Fr. Tulio belongs to the Yarumal Mission Society. He is a missionary priest who has served the people of God in Kenya and Ethiopia in Africa and in The Bronx, NY. He is originally from Colombia, South America. The goal of the

Yarumal Mission Society, founded 98 years ago, is to

witness the Gospel of Jesus Christ among people and cultures where the Gospel is not yet fully preached. They are present in Angola, Bolivia, Cambodia, Colombia, Ecuador, Côte d'Ivoire, Kenya, Panama and Thailand. To carry out their pastoral programs and social projects, the missionaries depend very much on the generosity of the Christians from parishes they

visit. Our support for Fr. Tulio and his missions, is a sign that reminds us of our baptismal vocation:





In today's Gospel story, Luke 10:38-42, Martha exercised the role expected of women in her culture when she entertained her guest. Mary assumed the role of the disciple. The story illustrated that Christian discipleship was open to both men and women. As you hear this reading, what words or phrases strike you? What in this reading touches your heart? What lingers in your memory?

Question for Children:

Name a time when you shared what you had with a friend, or a classmate at school.

Question for Youth:

Martha chose to serve, Mary chose to sit at Jesus' feet and listen to Him.

Of those two actions, service or prayer, which do you feel more comfortable with? Why?

Ouestion for Adults:

Do you see yourself as Mary or Martha or neither? Which one and why? Martha had the gift of hospitality (among other things), what is your gift? How are you using it for the Lord...or not using it?




