Saints Joachim and Anne are the patron saints of parenting and grandparents. Having been childless for the majority of their married life, the two continued to pray for God's favor and have hope. While Joachim retreated for prayer far from home, Anne grievously prayed for her husband's safety in exchange for dedicating any future child's life in service to God's plan. The two then shared a dream and vision where an angel told them that their fervent prayer had resulted in God choosing them to conceive a "wondrous" child. When Mary was born and became of age to be presented in the Temple, they brought her and followed the plan of God. Grandparents are special. # THANK YOU, FR. TULIO MXY




