

The Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas is committed to creating safe environments. In addition to attending a **Virtus Protecting God's Children for Adults** Awareness session, all employees and all volunteers working around youth or vulnerable adults must submit to a background check, read and sign our Archdiocesan policies regarding abuse prevention, ethics, and harassment. To maintain safe environments in our schools and parishes, the Archdiocese has ongoing requirements for our clergy, employees, and volunteers to remain in compliance. All Catholic School employees are required to complete background screenings and acknowledge policy every three years, and likewise every five years for all clergy, volunteers, and parish staff. The Office for Protection & Care oversees all the prevention efforts throughout the Archdiocese. As many of you know, our office partners with VIRTUS to implement many of the requirements. If you are a current employee or volunteer around youth or vulnerable adults, you will be notified through the VIRTUS platform via email when your background check comes up for renewal. Please log in to your existing VIRTUS account to complete the process within 30 days of notification. If you receive the notice and are no longer volunteering, please contact your Safe Environment Coordinator (SHSJ, Lisa Deghand, 785-234-3338; or HFCS, Sister Roberta, 785-234-8980). We rely heavily on our local SECs to ensure these requirements are met - please join us in sharing our gratitude for their tireless efforts! We are a community committed to preventing abuse. Our policies and programs prioritize safety of children and the vulnerable. We can all make an important difference by being a part of the safety net for our youth and vulnerable population. Thank you for doing your part.
