- b. The price of the Products and delivery charges will be those indicated on the Website at any given time. The prices of the Products and shipping costs may change according to what is agreed with the customer based on their needs. Currently, USAG does not accept online payments.
- c. Please note that this does not mean that your order has been accepted. Your order constitutes an offer to purchase a Product. All orders are subject to acceptance by USAG.
- d. By placing an order by any means, you warrant that you have legal capacity to enter binding contracts and are over 18 years old.

- 6. <u>License:</u> USAG grants the User a revocable, non-exclusive, non-transferable, and limited license to use our Website strictly in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. If the User breaches any of the Terms and Conditions, we reserve the right to block access without prior notice.
