This ministry reaches out and supports women in need of assistance during and beyond their pregnancy.



The spiritual life has its form of measurement too. When we are focused on God's will and put our faith into practice, we experience God's peace.


St. Paul says that this peace will 'stand guard' over our hearts and minds. There is a sense of satisfaction as we reap the (continued on back)


