Job Description

JOB SUMMARY

An Elementary Site Director will work to serve the community and families of the Gwinnett Mobile Home Park. The Site Director's responsibilities include providing structure and support to execute programs for K- 5, Middle School and High School students as determined by the Regional Director. This includes building and maintaining relationships with students throughout the year, and supporting students' academic, social, and spiritual development.

Academically, this includes support in the following areas: building partnerships with local schools, working collaboratively with staff to encourage student success. Support and encouragement for parents/guardians to take an active role in their child's education, equipping them with skills and resources to lead their child at home.

Spiritually, this includes support by teaching and modeling the love of Jesus through words and actions. Our actions at Path United are based on our core values: honesty,

curiosity, dignity, integrity and vulnerability. These attributes are essential to our mission, integral to the structure of our programs, and represent the overall character of our organization.

Socially, this includes support by fostering healthy development by providing opportunities for interaction with community leaders, encouraging service to others, promoting career and college exploration, and other developmentally appropriate experiences that promote social intelligence.

The role of Site Director is multifaceted. The heart of the job is building consistent, positive relationships with students and providing long-term mentorship to support them through crucial developmental phases.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- I. Personal confession of faith in Jesus Christ and commitment to the mission and vision of Path United.
- II. Bachelor's degree in a related field such as education, social work, child development, communications, or counseling—or equivalent experience in a related position.
- III. Agreement with Path United Core Values – Honesty, Curiosity, Dignity, Integrity and Vulnerability.
- IV. Observable traits of Christ-like humility, compassion and generosity with time, talents and treasure.
- V. Established track record of taking initiative and working well as part of a team.
- VI. Teachable - receptive to constructive feedback and eager to learn.
- VII. Awareness of, or willingness to learn, the cultural and socioeconomic factors that influence behavior and development in our neighborhoods.
- VIII. Excellent oral and written communication skills. Bilingual proficiency in English and Spanish is highly preferred but not required. Candidates who are not bilingual must be comfortable learning basic Spanish phrases to communicate effectively with students and families.
- IX. Servant heart – enjoys serving behind the scenes, tending to details and performing basic custodial maintenance of community centers.
- X. Strong organizational skills, including effective time management and management of student behavior, particularly in a group setting.
- XI. Ability to remain organized, adaptable, and composed during occasional periods of increased activity or unexpected challenges.

EMPLOYMENT DETAILS

Schedule

This is a full-time, exempt position consisting of approximately 32 hours per week. Working hours are divided among program activities, building relationships with students and parents/guardians, visiting local schools, and completing administrative and program-preparation responsibilities.

June is a full, active month that includes camps and other seasonal activities. Site Directors should expect their schedules to differ from the regular school year, and flexible availability during this month is essential.

July is a paid sabbatical month with no scheduled programs or activities for students or staff.

Compensation

Compensation for this exempt position is \$45,000 per year.

Time Off

Time off generally follows the school calendar for the employee's designated county, as outlined in the employee handbook. Site Directors also receive personal days each calendar year based on their employment status.
