

Brothers and Sisters, I am pleased to share the outcome of the business conducted during the Special portion of our Union meeting last month. First, as you were made aware, nominations for Delegates to the 40th U.A. General Convention were to be made last month, which they were, and with elections by secret ballot to have taken place on April 26th. With my position as Business Manager being an automatic Delegate, four (4) Delegate spots remained and only four (4) nominations were made. A motion was then made for the Recording Secretary to a cast a single ballot for each of the nominees, which was seconded and carried.

Next, as discussed and voted on by the membership during the Special portion of our March Union meeting, below is the outcome on our wage disbursements effective May 1, 2021 - April 30, 2022.

The allocations were approved as follows:

Increase to Wage - \$0.35 /hr*

Increase to Annuity - \$0.50/hr

Increase to Local 773 Pension - \$0.15/hr

Increase to Health & Welfare - \$0.30

*The \$0.35 increase to the wage will be allocated to the Vacation Fund.

The Local 773 Benefits Office will be mailing out Open Enrollment packets the last week of April. It is very important that you review the packet. If you wish to make any changes to your coverage, the request must be submitted by May 31, 2021 for an effective date of June 1, 2021. Local 773 remains insured on a self-insured basis with CDPHP (medical) and Delta Dental (dental). Prescription coverage remains on a self-insured basis with Express Scripts. Vision coverage is now provided through NVA. Please read the packet for more information.

We would like to take a moment to again advise our members and participants in the plan to help keep costs down for our self-funded insurance plan by remaining cautious in the use of the plan, taking care to visit urgent care centers as opposed to the emergency room when the situation permits. Not only will this save you time and money, but it will help to keep our premiums, and the corresponding cost to the member, which are directly influenced by our group's claims, affordable. COVID-19 can have serious, life-threatening complications. All COVID-19 vaccines currently available in the United States have been shown to be highly effective at preventing COVID-19. Stopping a pandemic requires using all the tools we have available. The COVID-19 vaccinations are an important tool that can help stop the pandemic. In NYS, eligibility has been opened to all aged 16 and over.

The federal government is providing the vaccine free of charge to all people living in the United States, regardless of their immigration or health insurance status.

The decision to be vaccinated is your own to make. We ask you to consider all facts and information at your disposal before making a decision.
